The leading event in Australia's international education calendar will head to Victoria next year, with Melbourne announced as host of the 30th Australian International Education Conference (AIEC) in October 2016.

AIEC 2016 will be held from 18 to 21 October 2016 at the Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre, and will be jointly presented by IDP Education and the International Education Association of Australia.
