Department of Education and Training

The **Department of Education and Training** works with the education sector, other government agencies and ministries to ensure Australia is recognised as a regional and world leader in education and a partner of choice for international collaboration.

Mobility Grants

The **Australia Awards-Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships** are the Australian Government's competitive, merit-based scholarships and fellowships providing opportunities for Australians to undertake study, research or professional development overseas and for overseas citizens to do the same in Australia.

The Australian Government encourages Australian students to immerse themselves in the academic and social cultures of other countries. Endeavour Mobility Grants supports two-way engagement between Australia and the rest of the world through student mobility.



The **New Colombo Plan** is a signature initiative of the Australian Government which aims to lift knowledge of the Indo-Pacific in Australia by supporting Australian undergraduates to study and undertake internships in the region.



Australia Global Alumni is a whole-of-government public diplomacy initiative developed in partnership with Australia's education sector. It aims to grow a global alumni community that actively engages and promotes Australia and advances Australia's national interests.



The **Overseas Students Ombudsman** is a specialist role of the Commonwealth Ombudsman which investigates complaints about problems that intending, current or former overseas students have with private education providers in Australia.

Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency

The **Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA)** is Australia's national regulator of the higher education sector. TEQSA safeguards student interests and the reputation of higher education in Australia by assuring the quality of higher education providers through a proportionate, risk-reflective approach to regulation.

OMBUDSMAN

The **Fair Work Ombudsman** is an independent government agency created by the Fair Work Act 2009. It provides free education and information about people's basic rights and protections in the workplace, including minimum pay and conditions. It also helps to resolve workplace issues, conduct investigations, and enforce relevant Commonwealth workplace laws.

Department of Immigration and Border Protection

The **Department of Immigration and Border Protection** is responsible for immigration and customs border policy. Our mission is to protect Australia's border and manage the movement of people and goods across it.

The Department manages the Migration Programme including international student visa policy, the Humanitarian Programme, Australian citizenship, trade and customs, offshore maritime security and revenue collection.



International Skills Training Courses

Skills for industry

The **International Skills Training (IST)** courses program is a new Australian Government initiative that oversees the delivery of training courses specifically designed for the offshore international student market. The aim of these non-Australian Qualifications Framework courses is to address critical competency gaps, support global skills needs, and provide Australian registered training organisations (RTOs) the opportunity to offer additional products to support overseas stakeholders to meet their diverse skills needs.
