- New work underway on communicating the benefits

Informs government policy and investment

- Work of India Reference Group will inform implementation of an India Economic Strategy
- Deep dives on the VET and schools sectors will shape govt strategies
- Deep dive on agents will complement govt transparency work
- Results in more cohesive govt engagement and better policy outcomes for the sector
