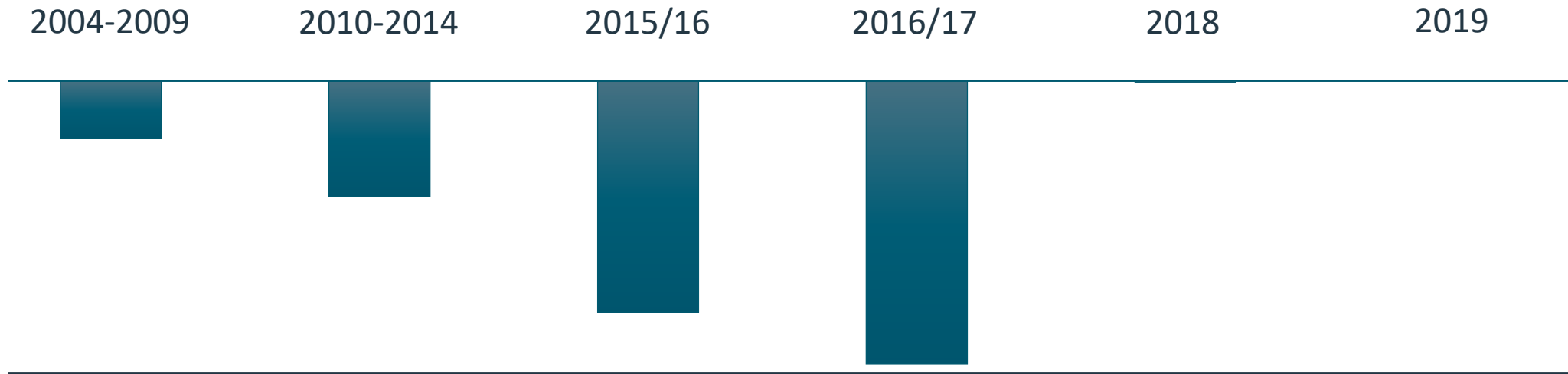

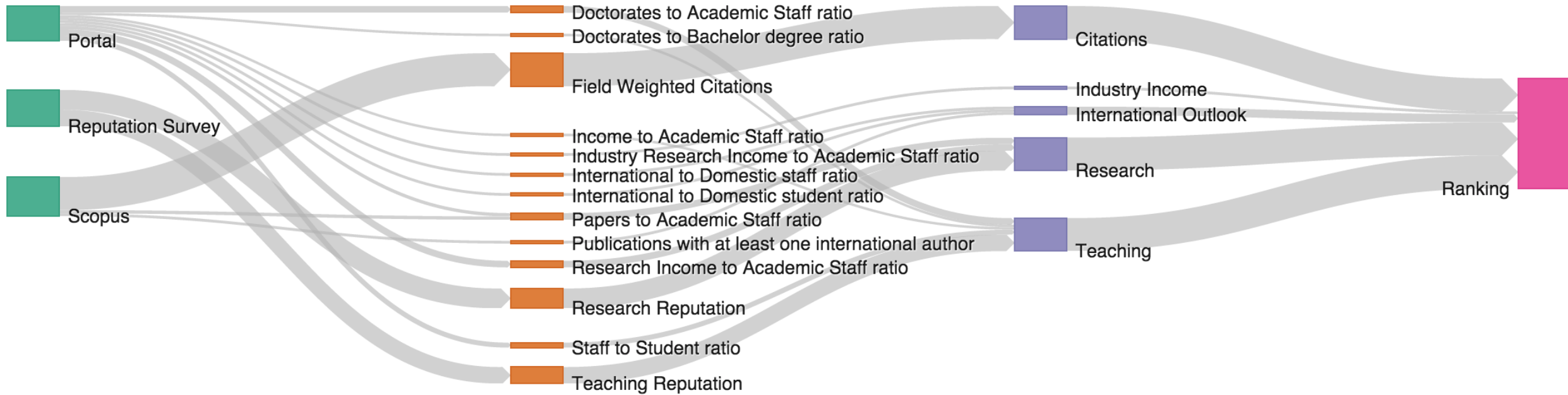

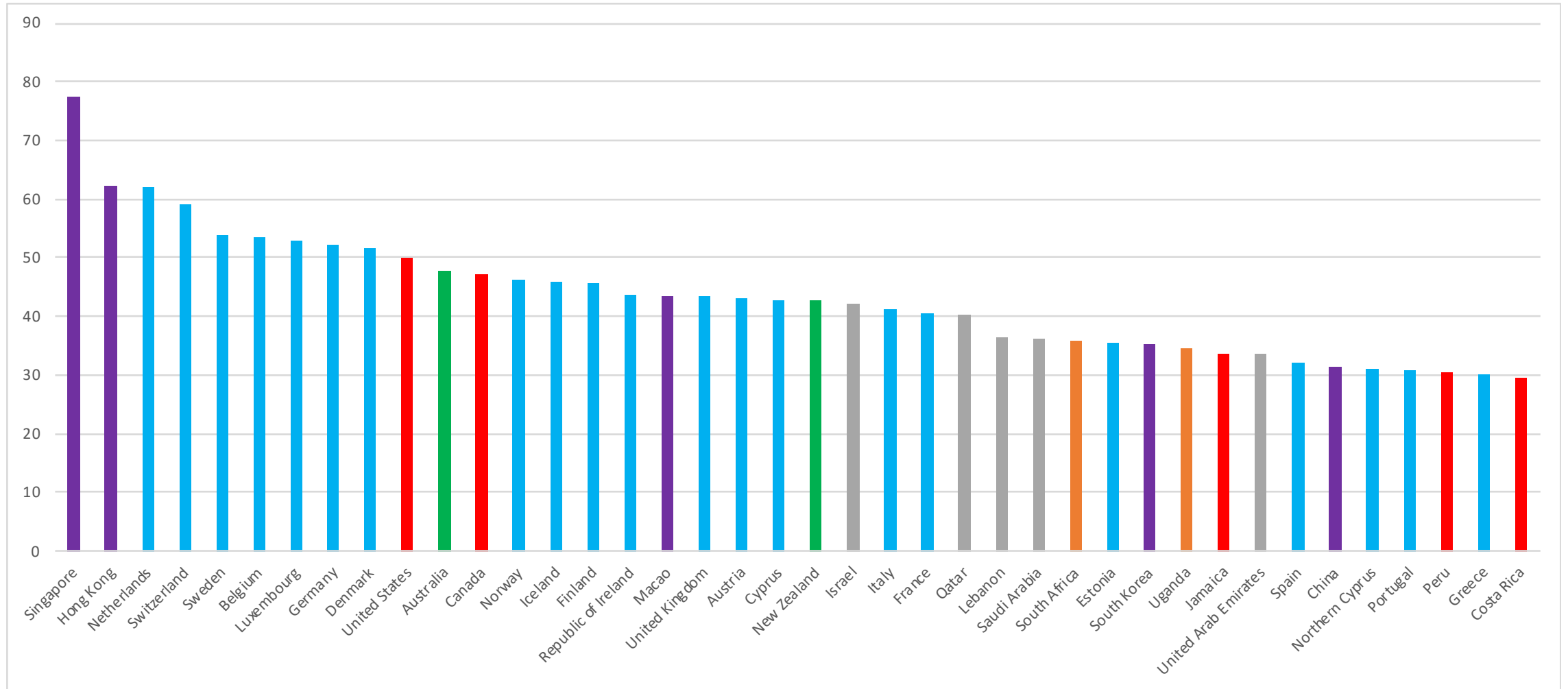

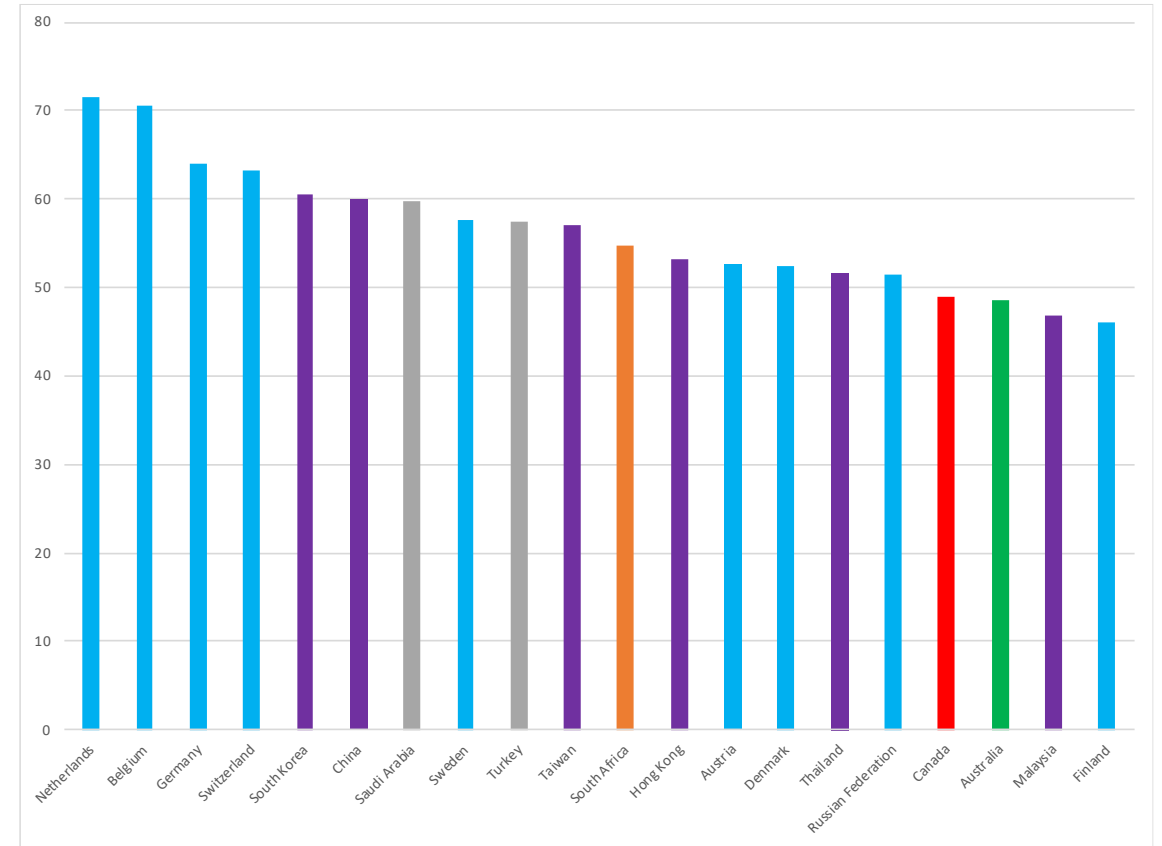
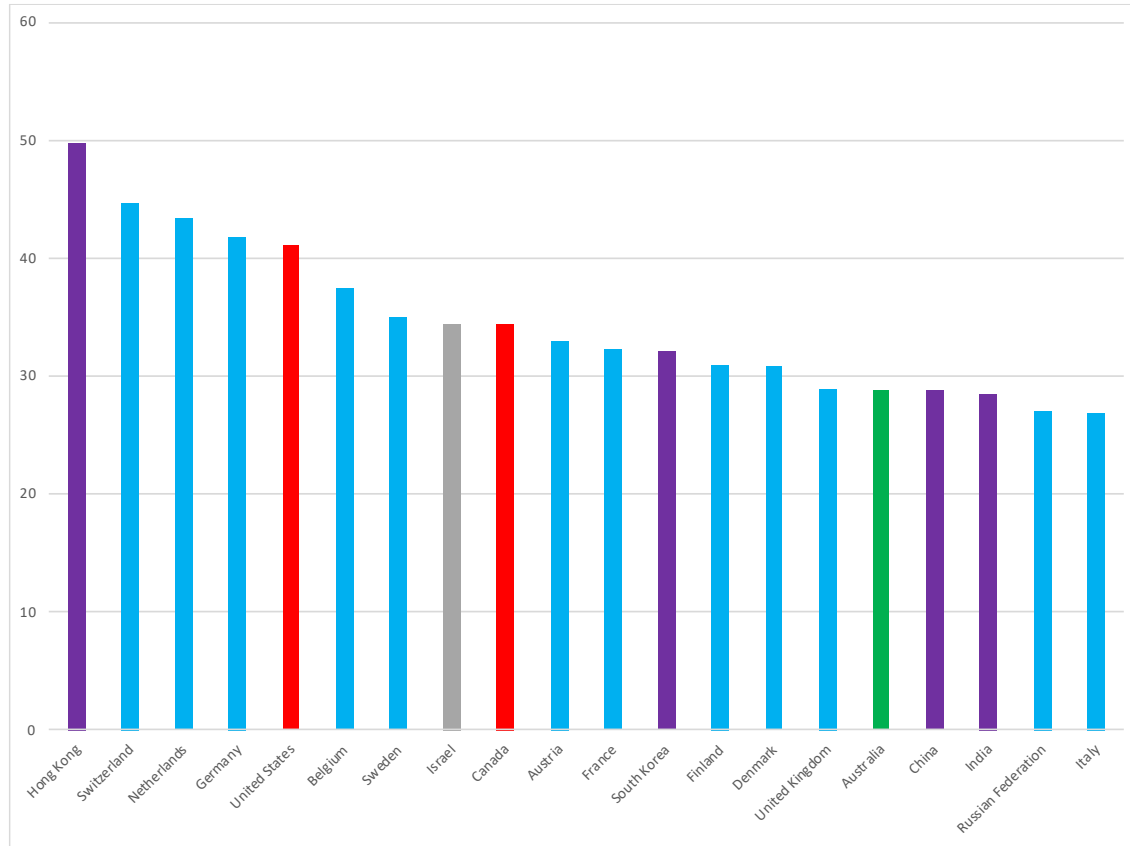
Overall performance 2019



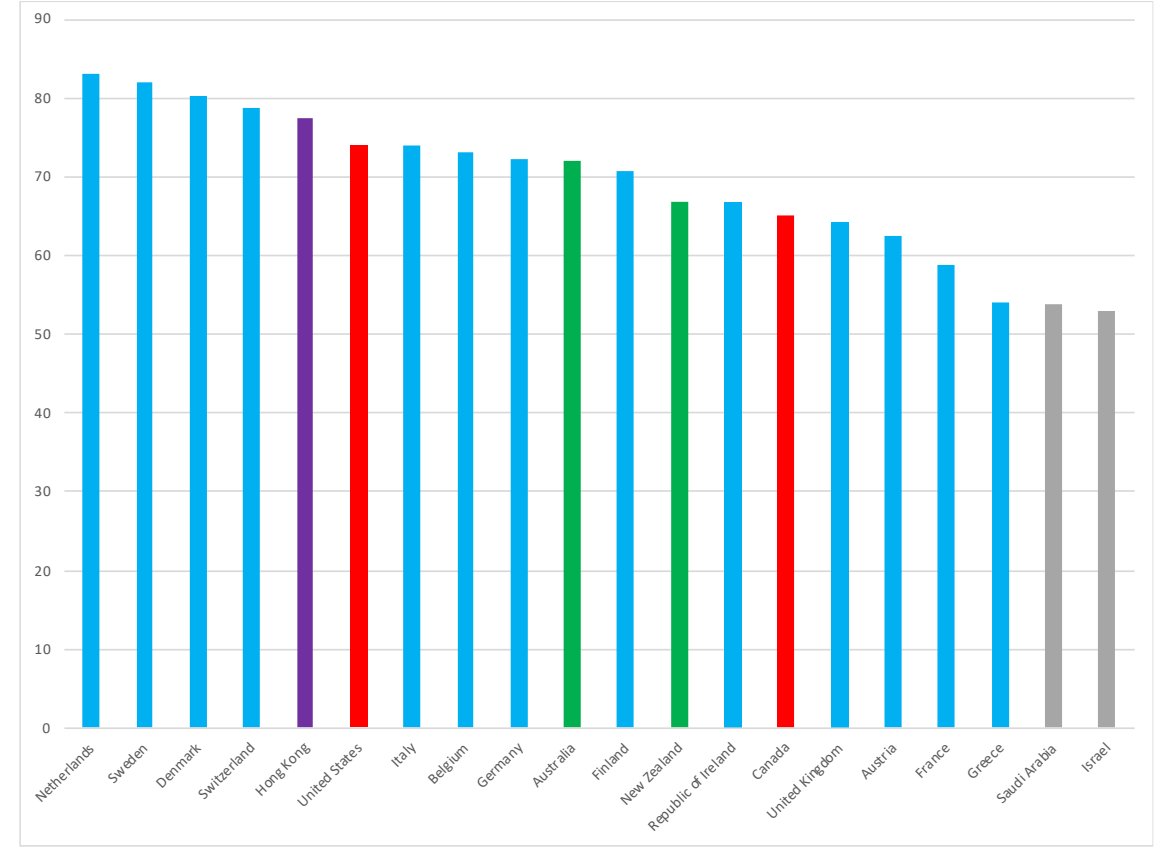
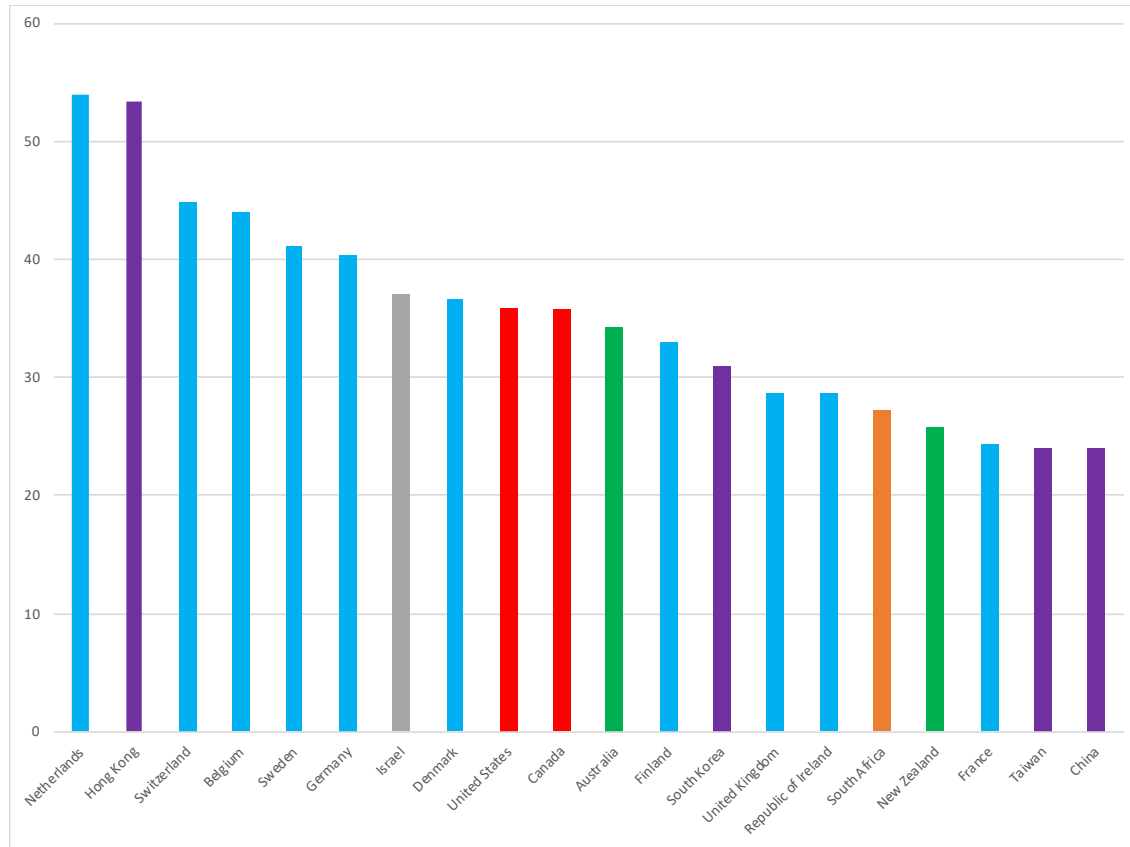
Overall performance (n>5)



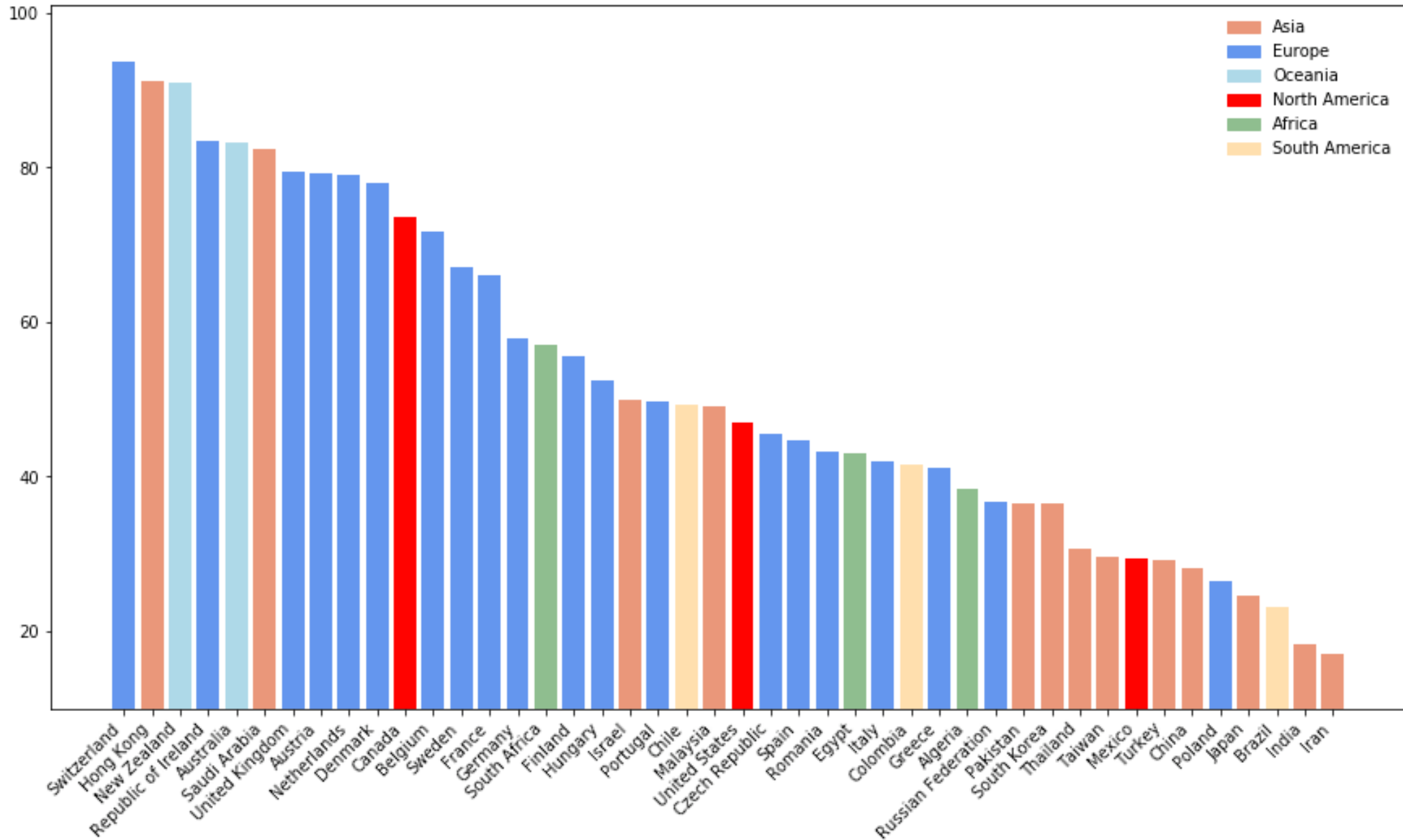
Teaching and Industry Income (n>5)

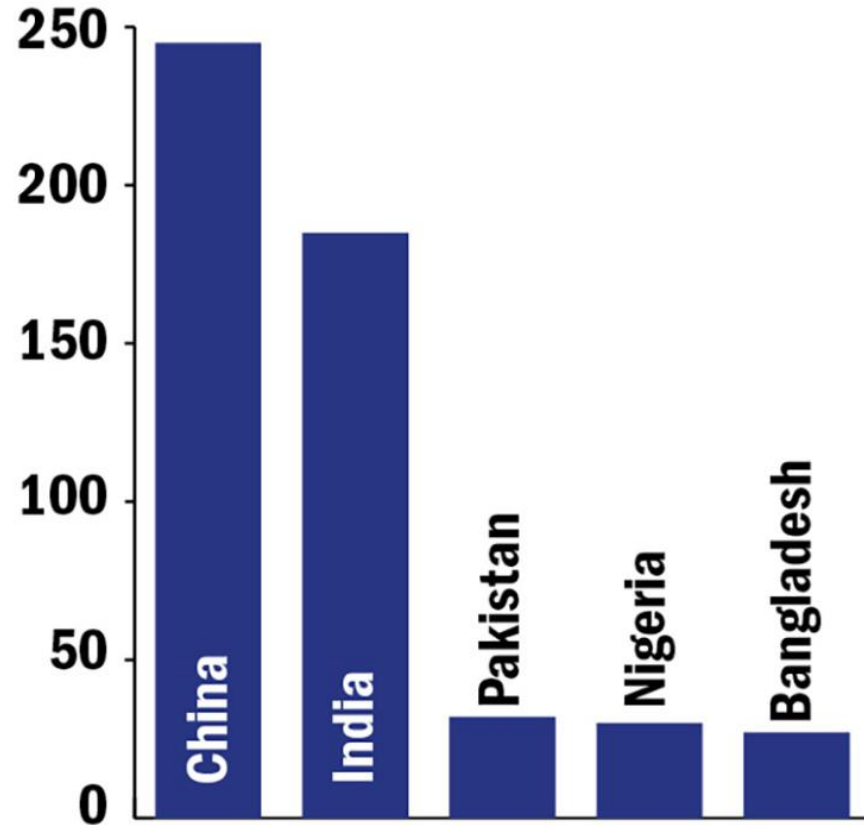

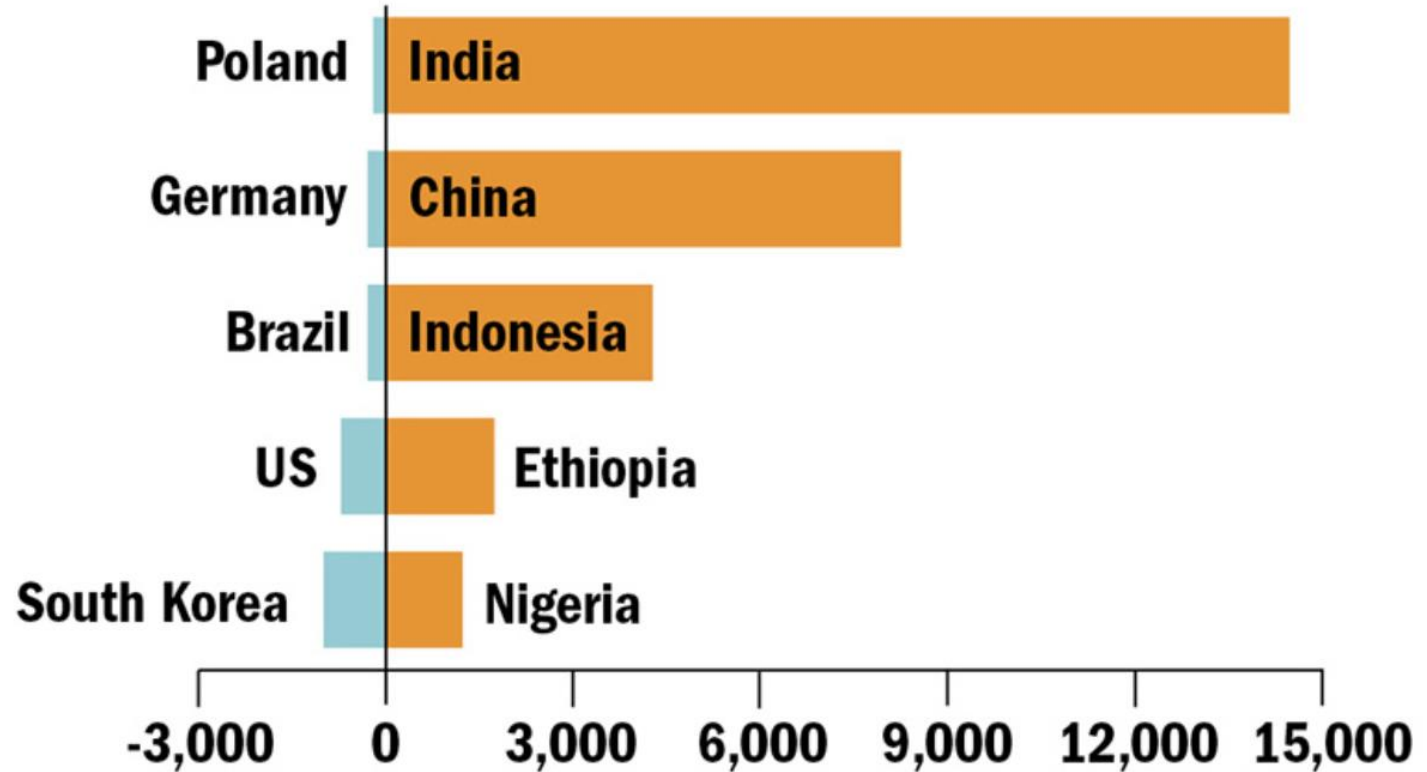
Exports: student sources

Growth in outbound students (000s), 2015-27: top five

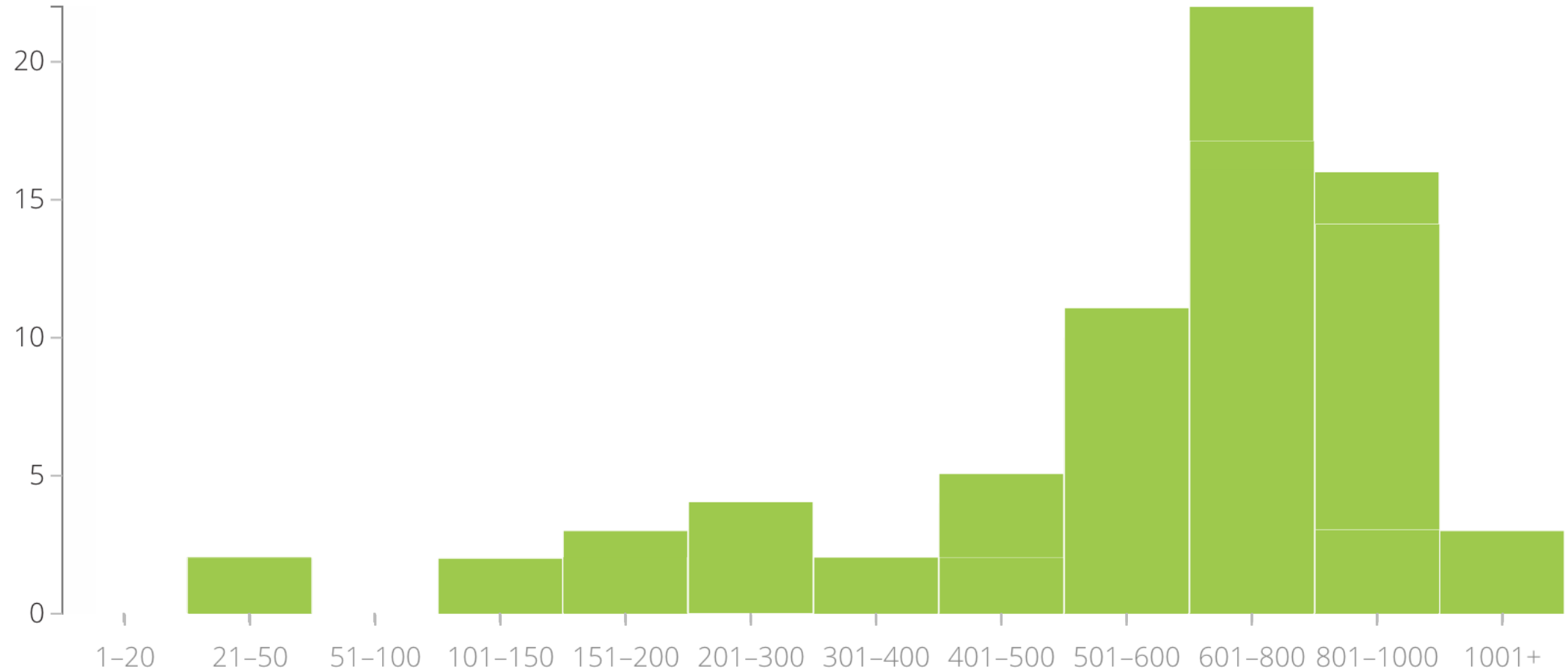


Ups and downs: countries with largest rises and falls in tertiary enrolment

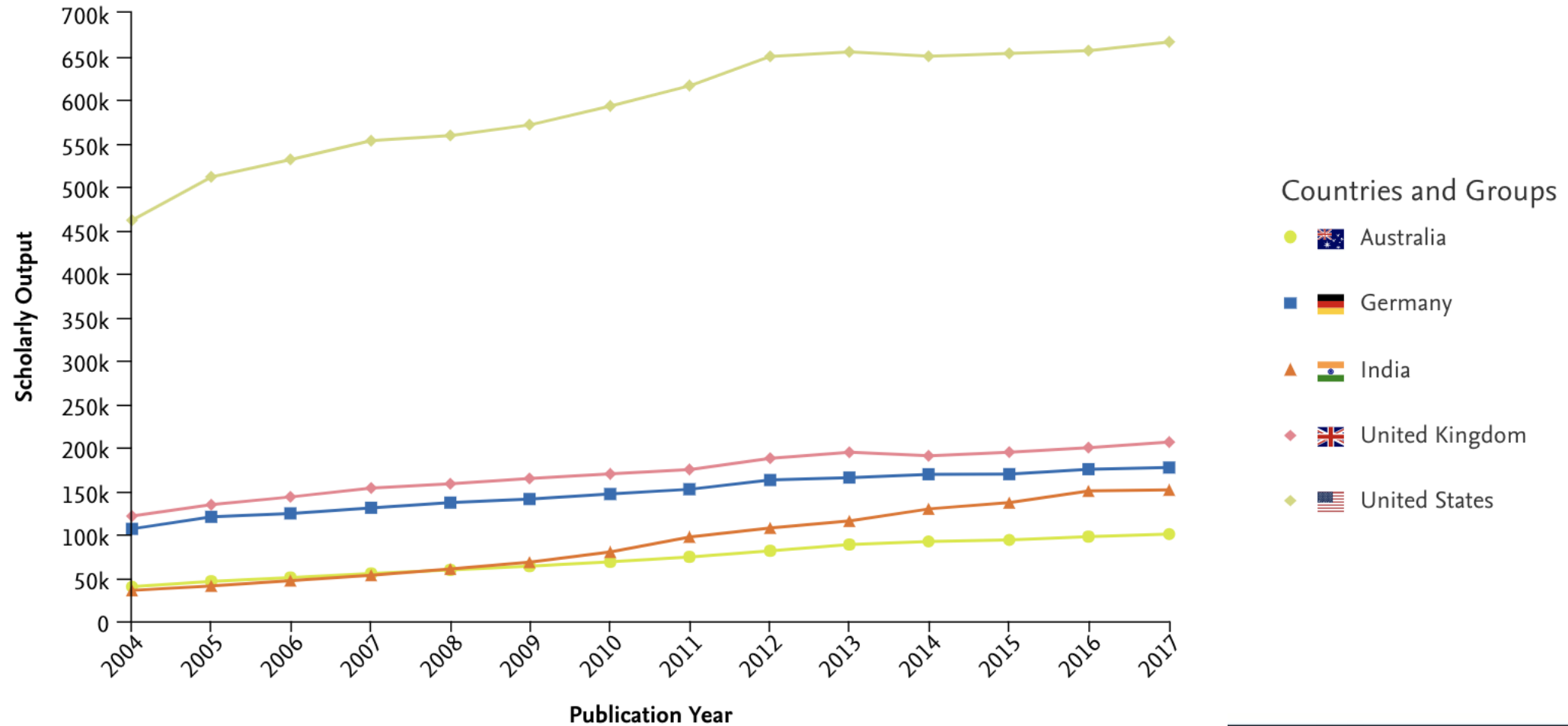
Increasing and decreasing tertiary enrolment (000s), 2015-27: top five



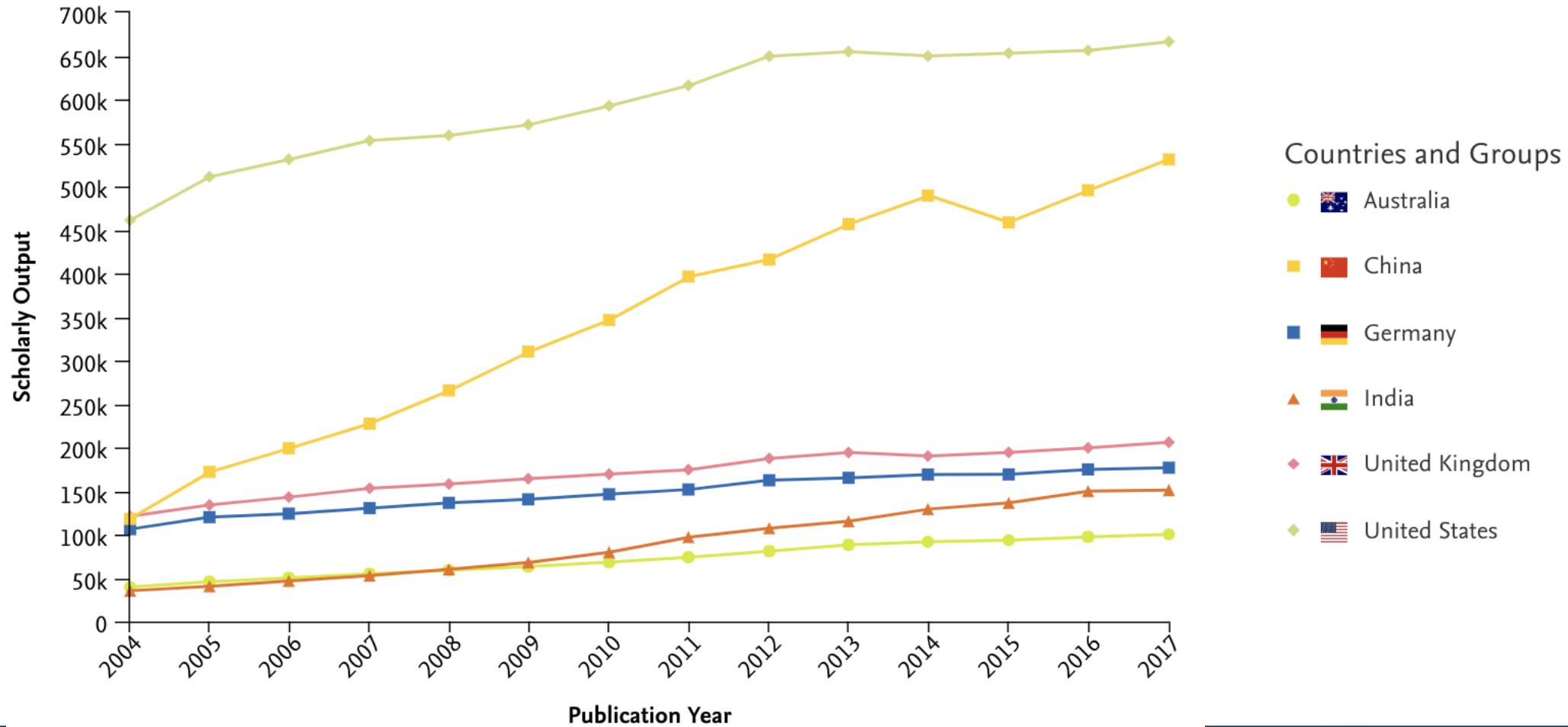
The rise of China from 40 Universities to 72



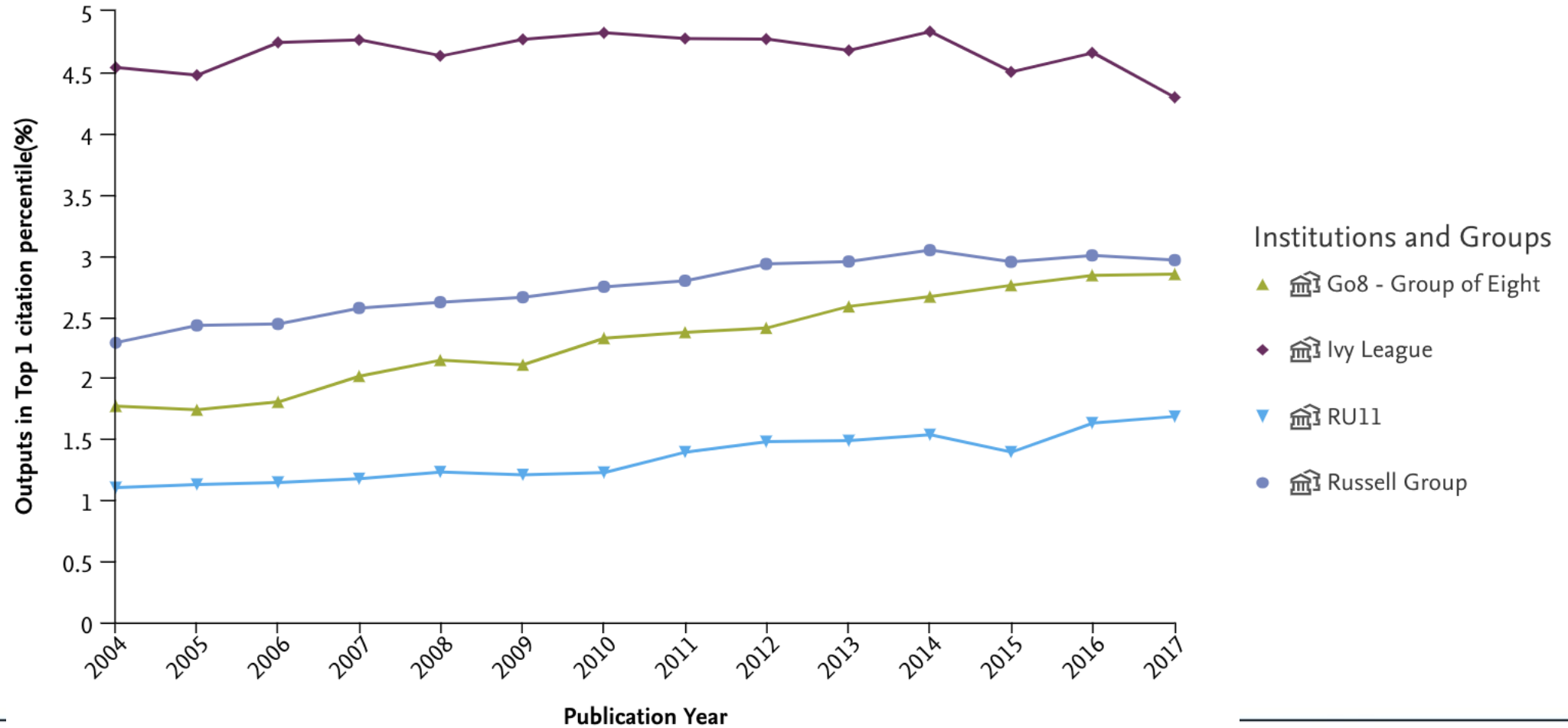
Scholarly output: US, UK, Germany, India and Australia



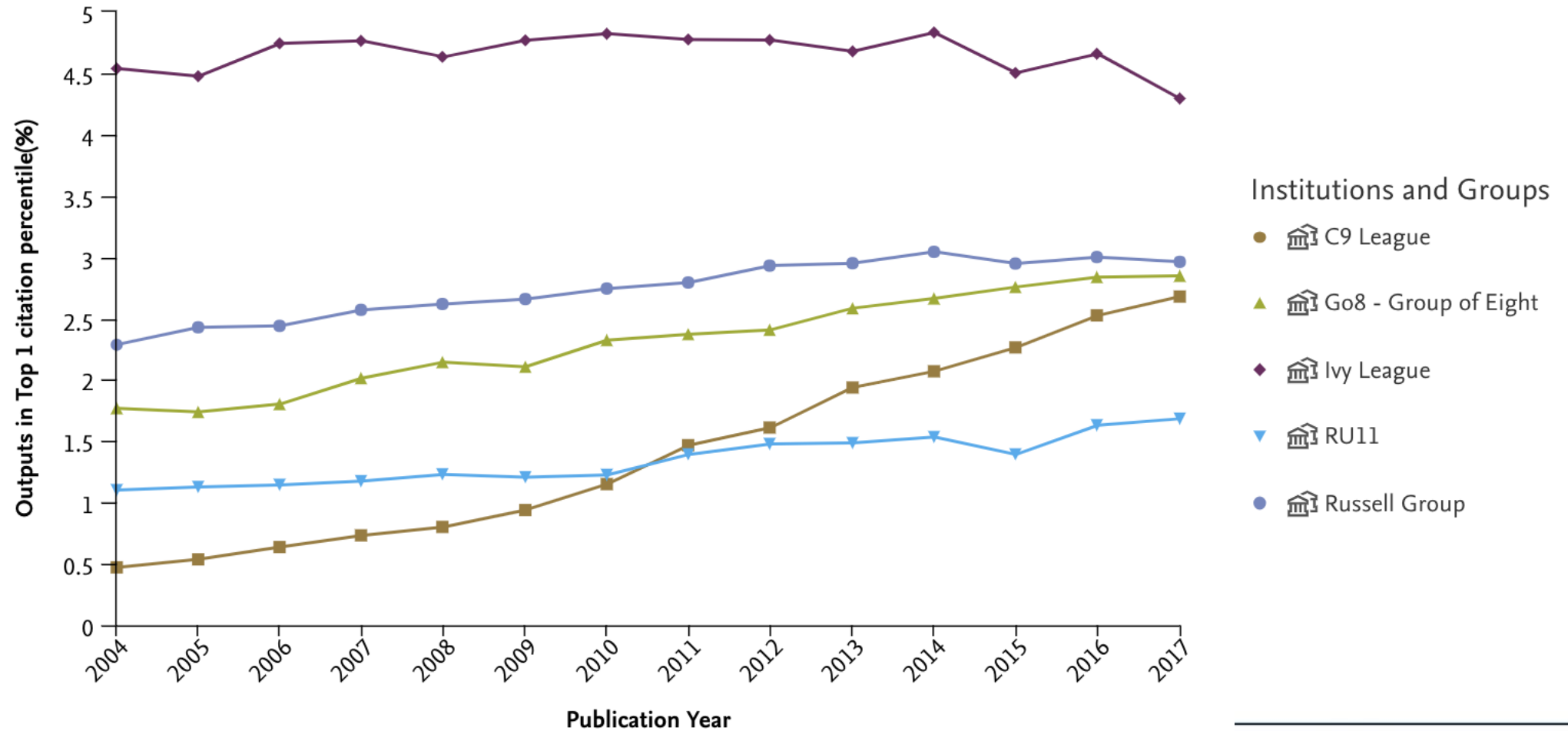
Scholarly output: US, UK, Germany, India, Australia and China

Percentage of publications that are highly cited: Elite university groupings

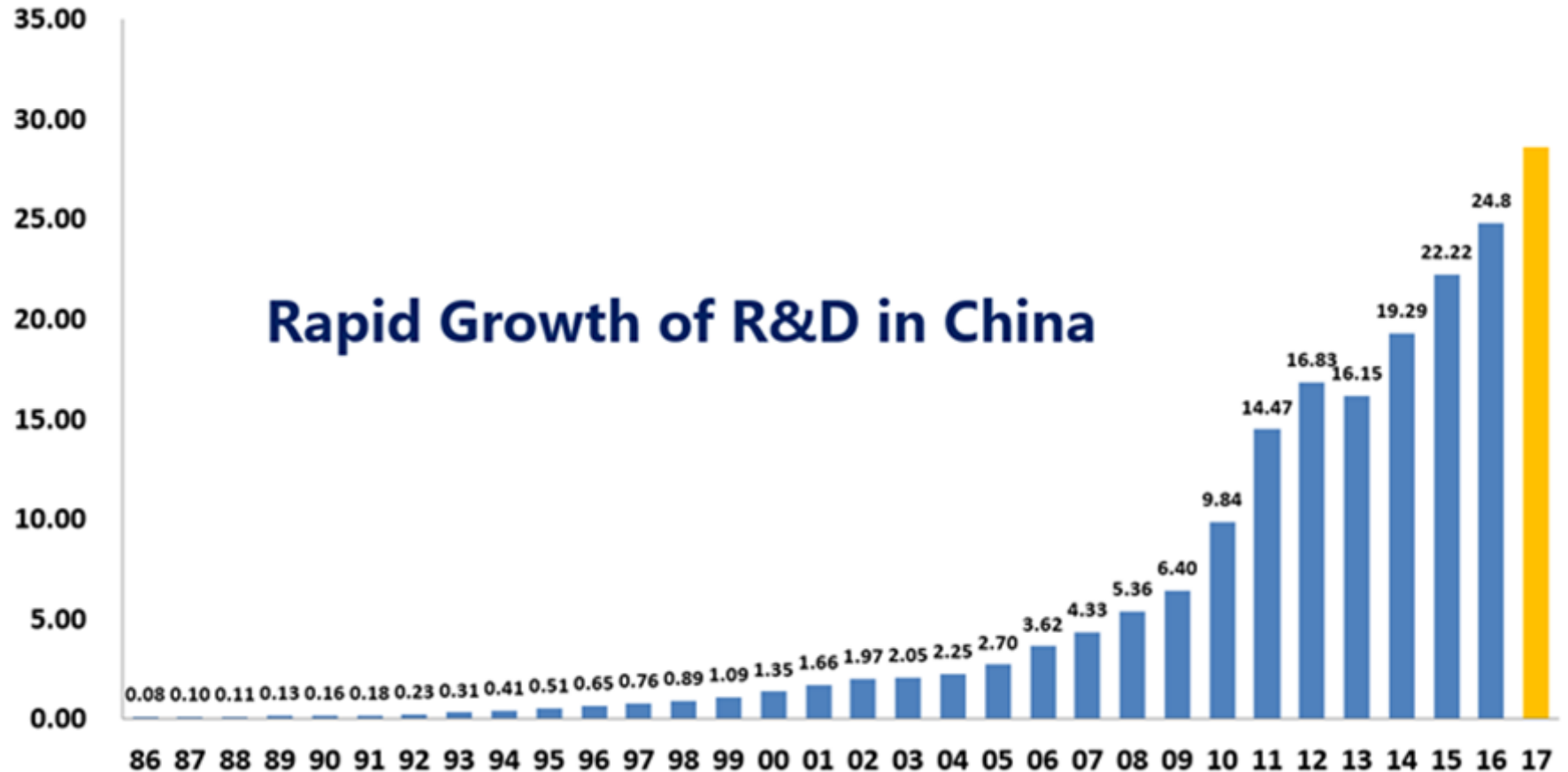


R&D funding in China

Now stands at 28 billion RMB (£3.2 billion).

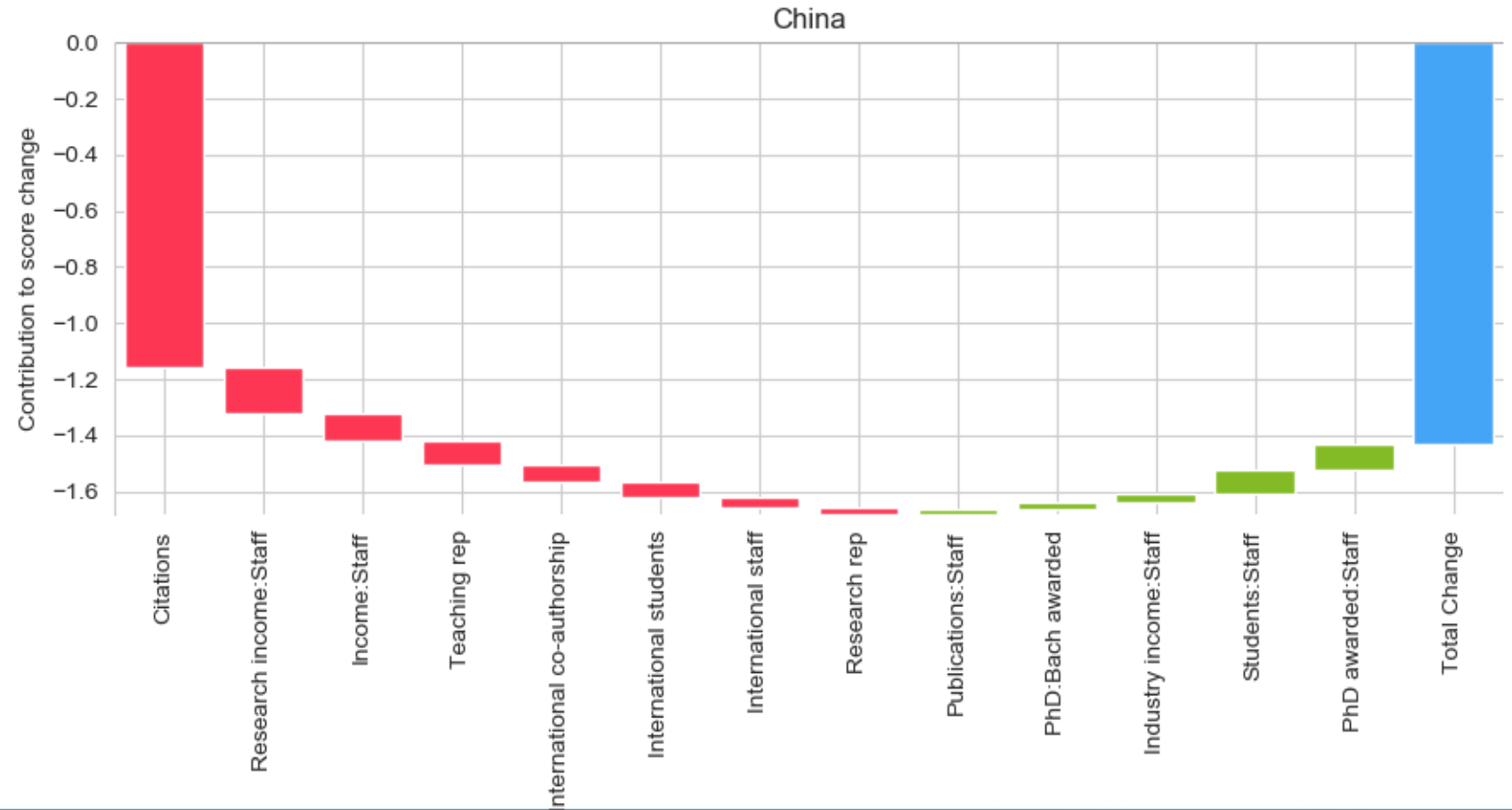




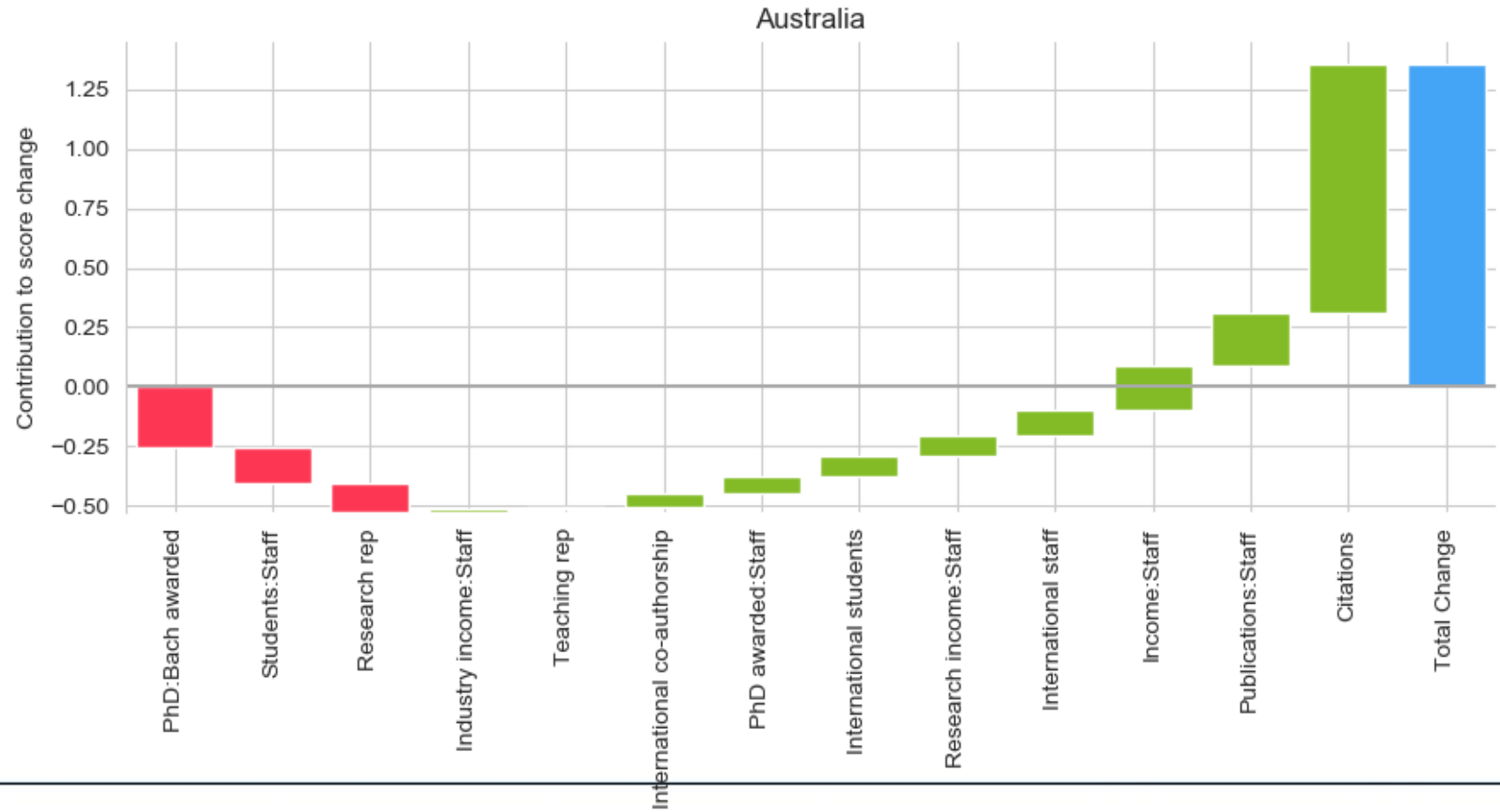

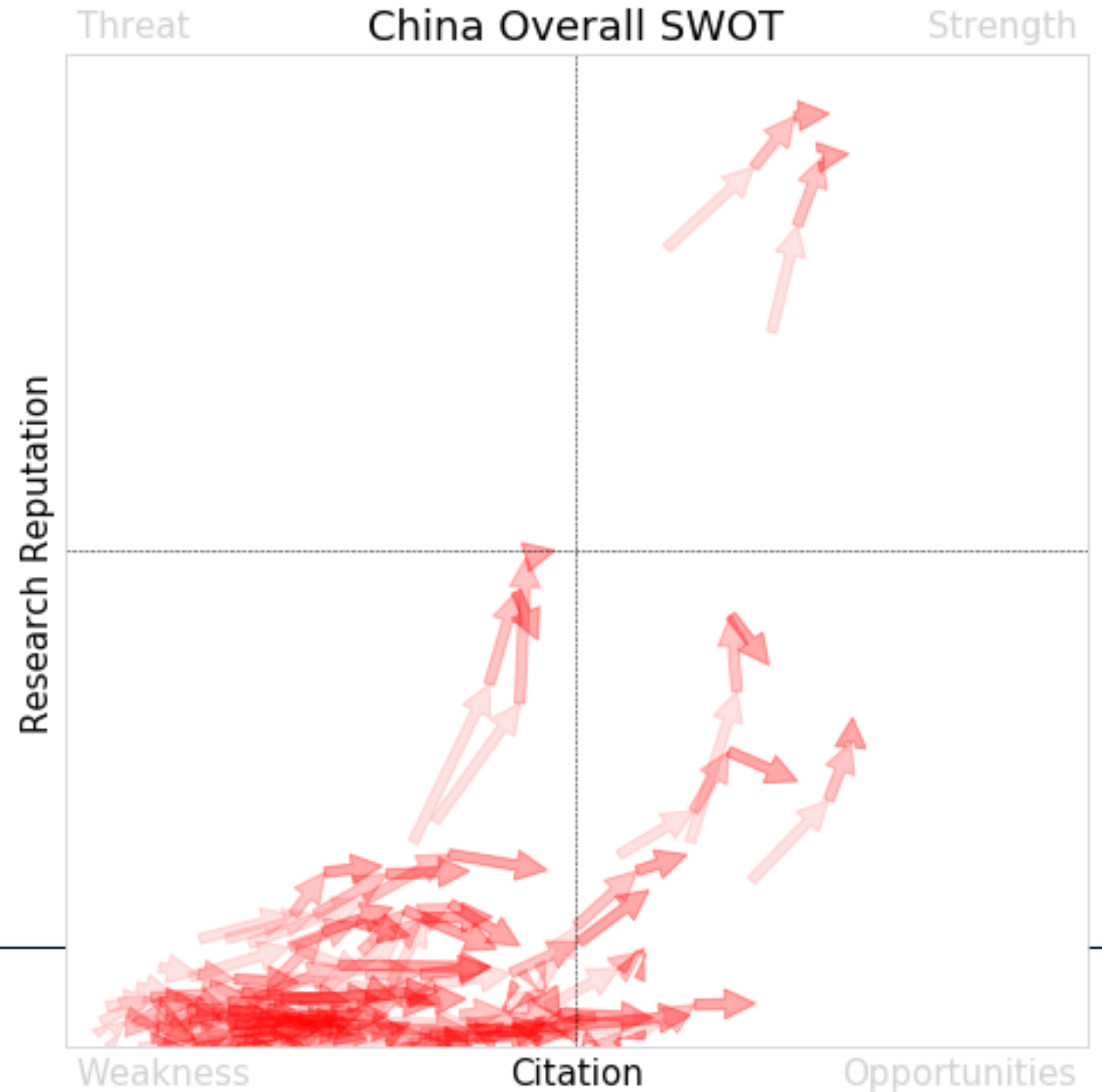

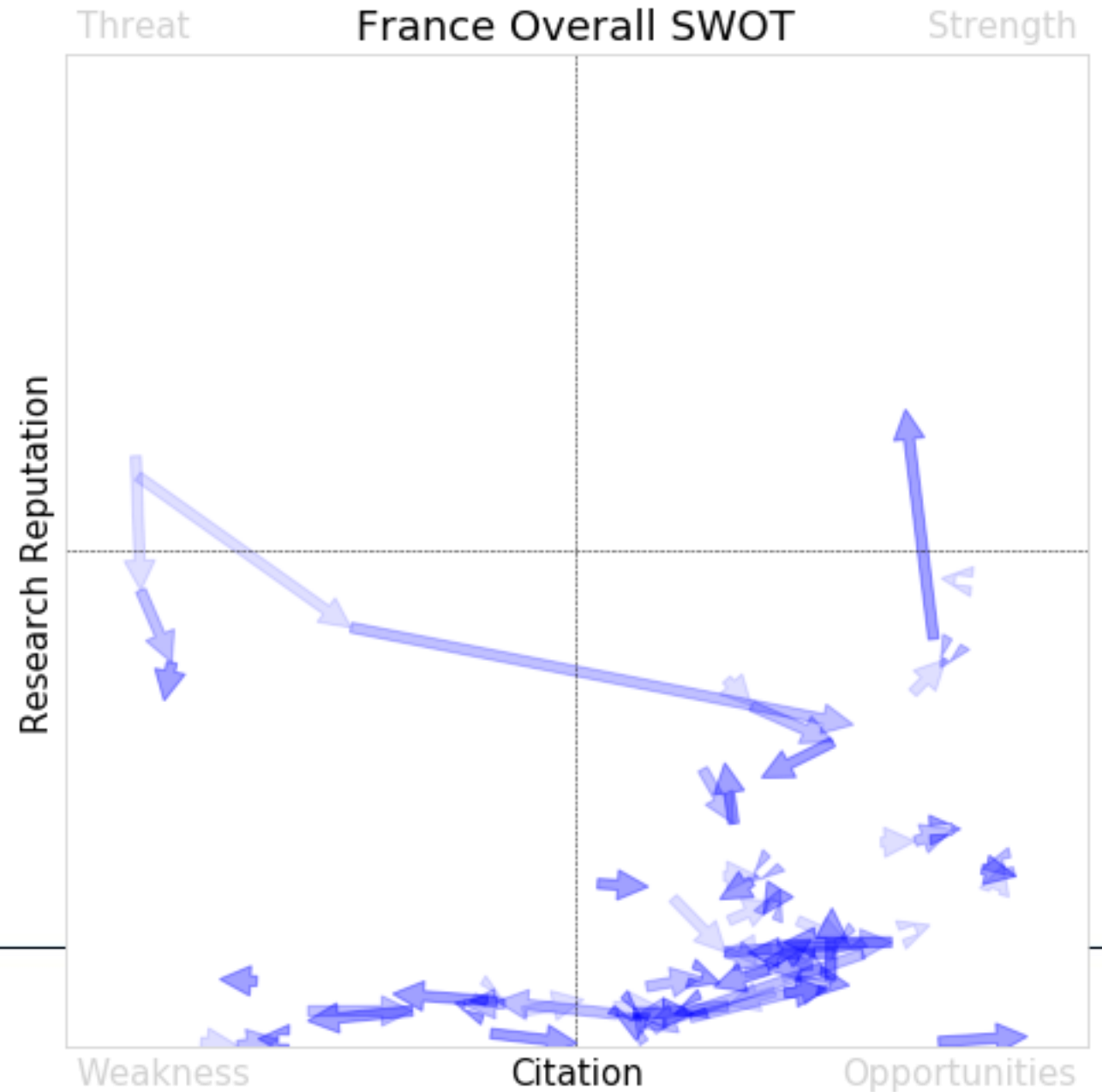

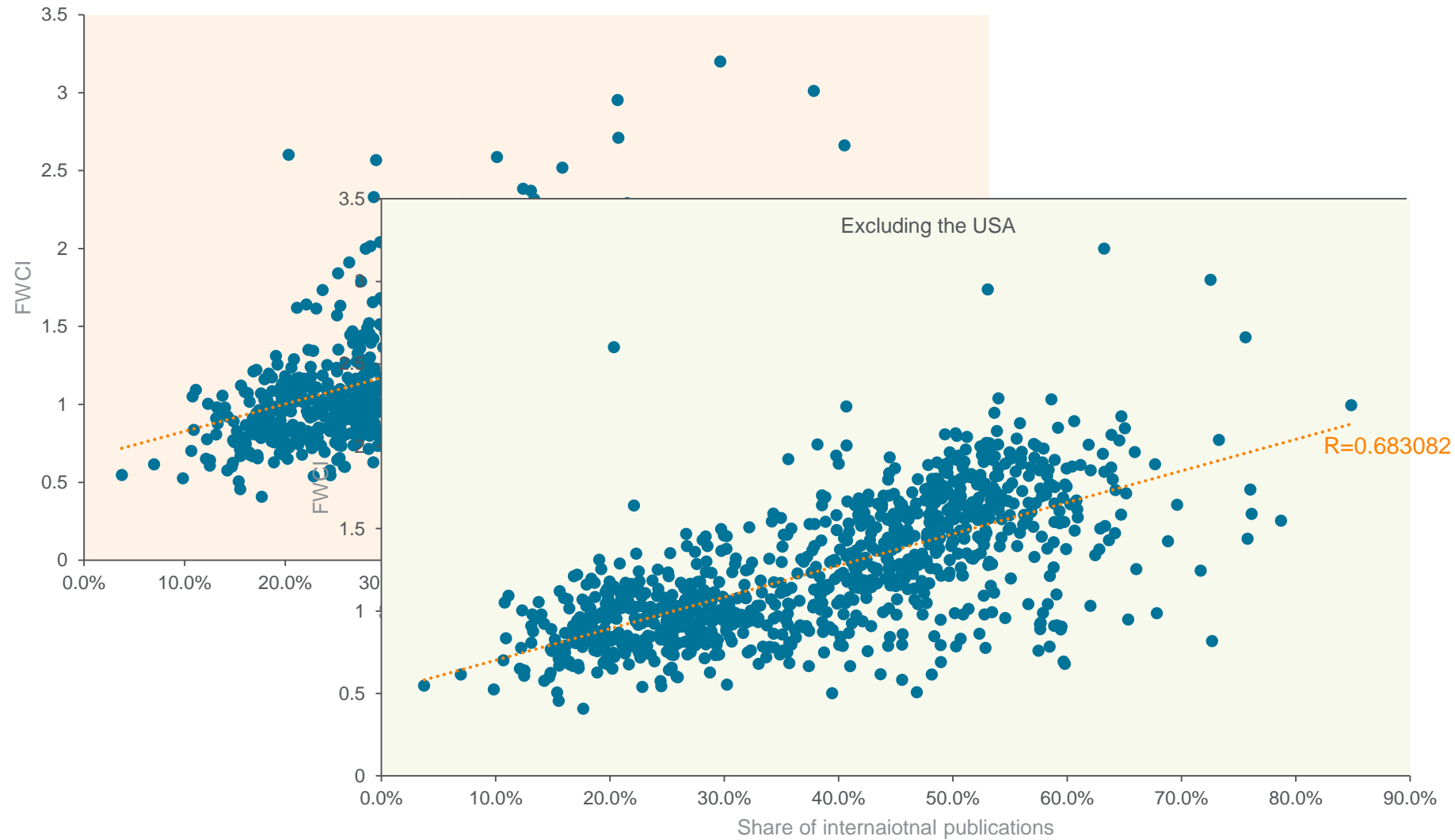

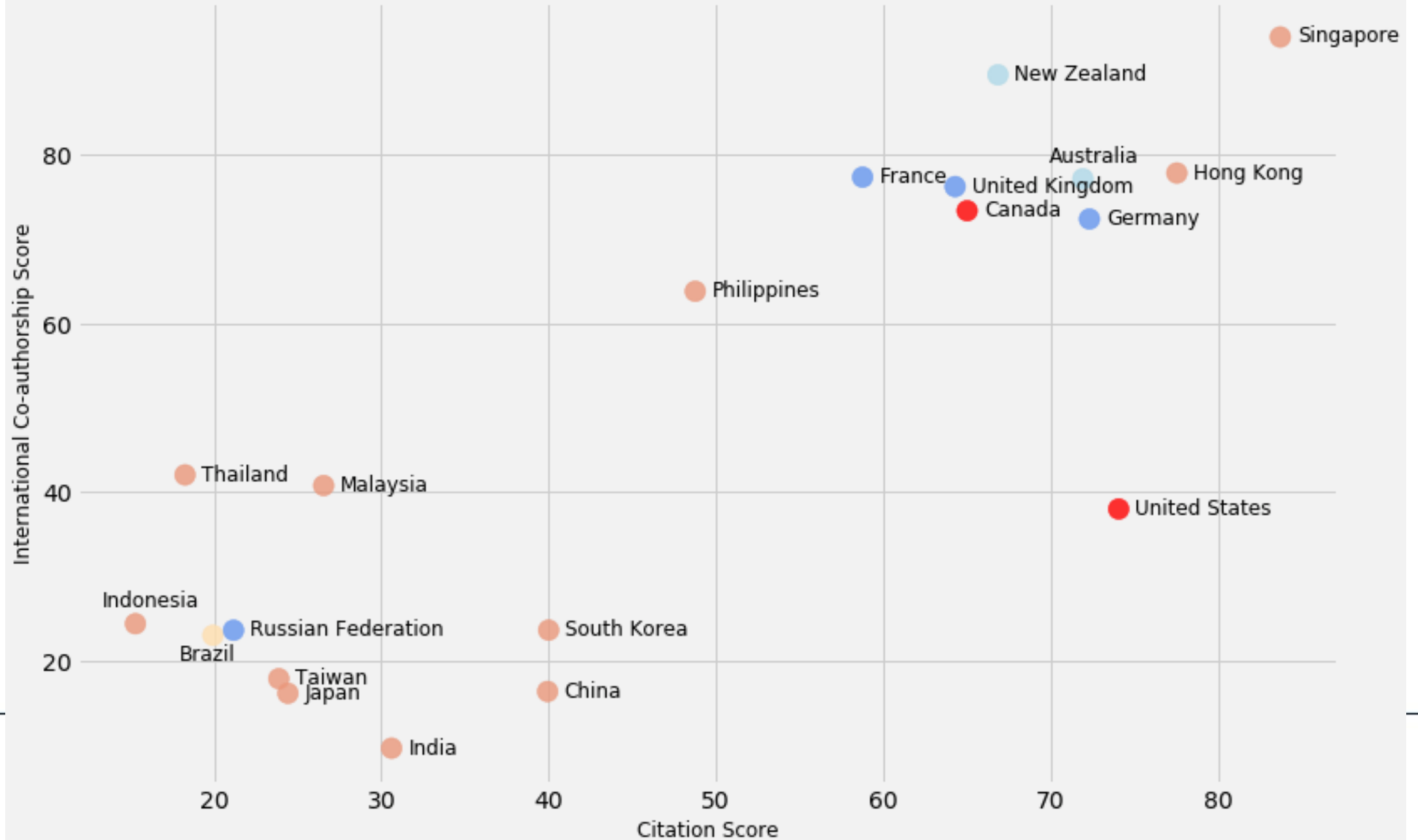
World vs. Australia



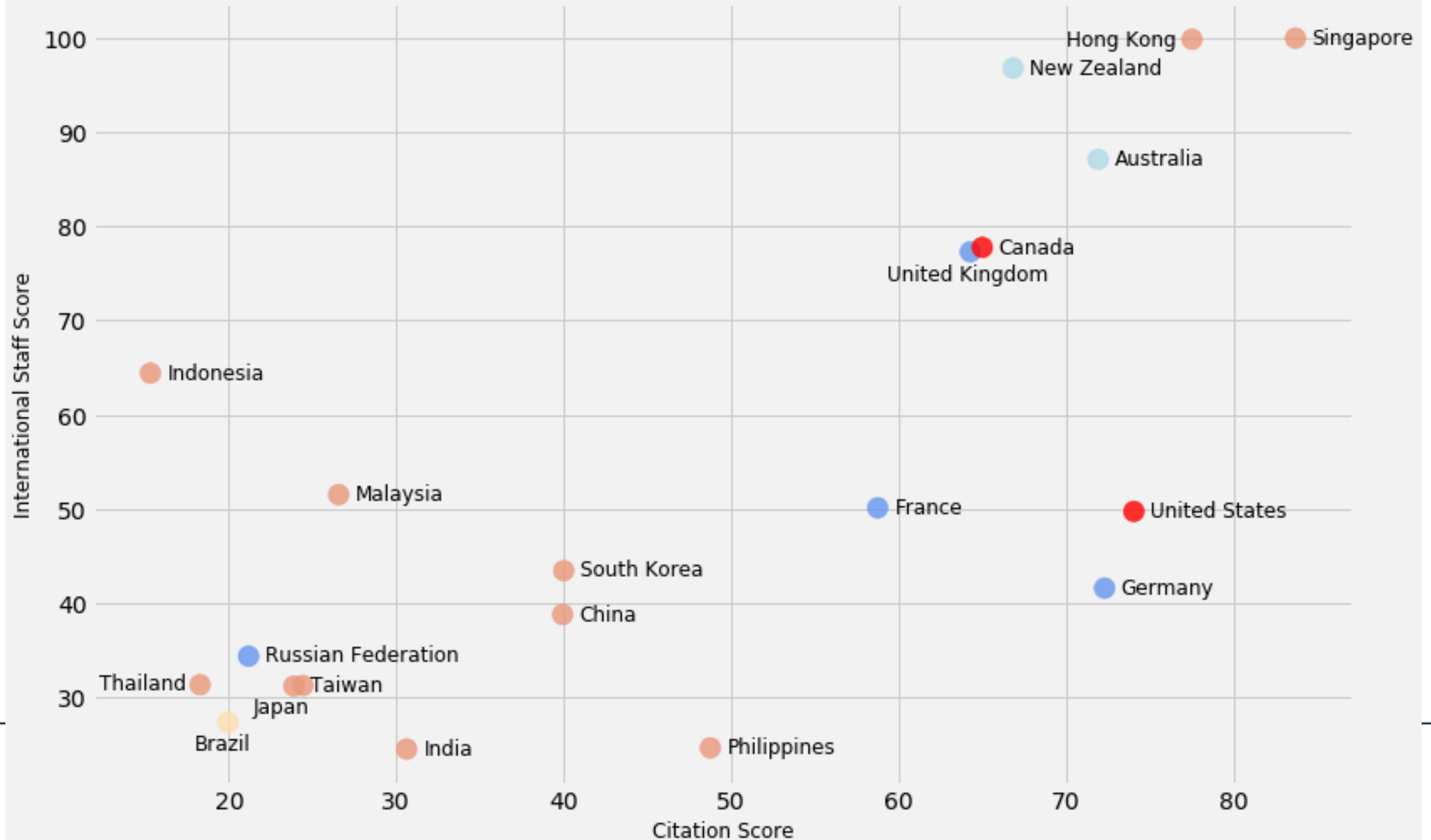
International publications vs. FWCI



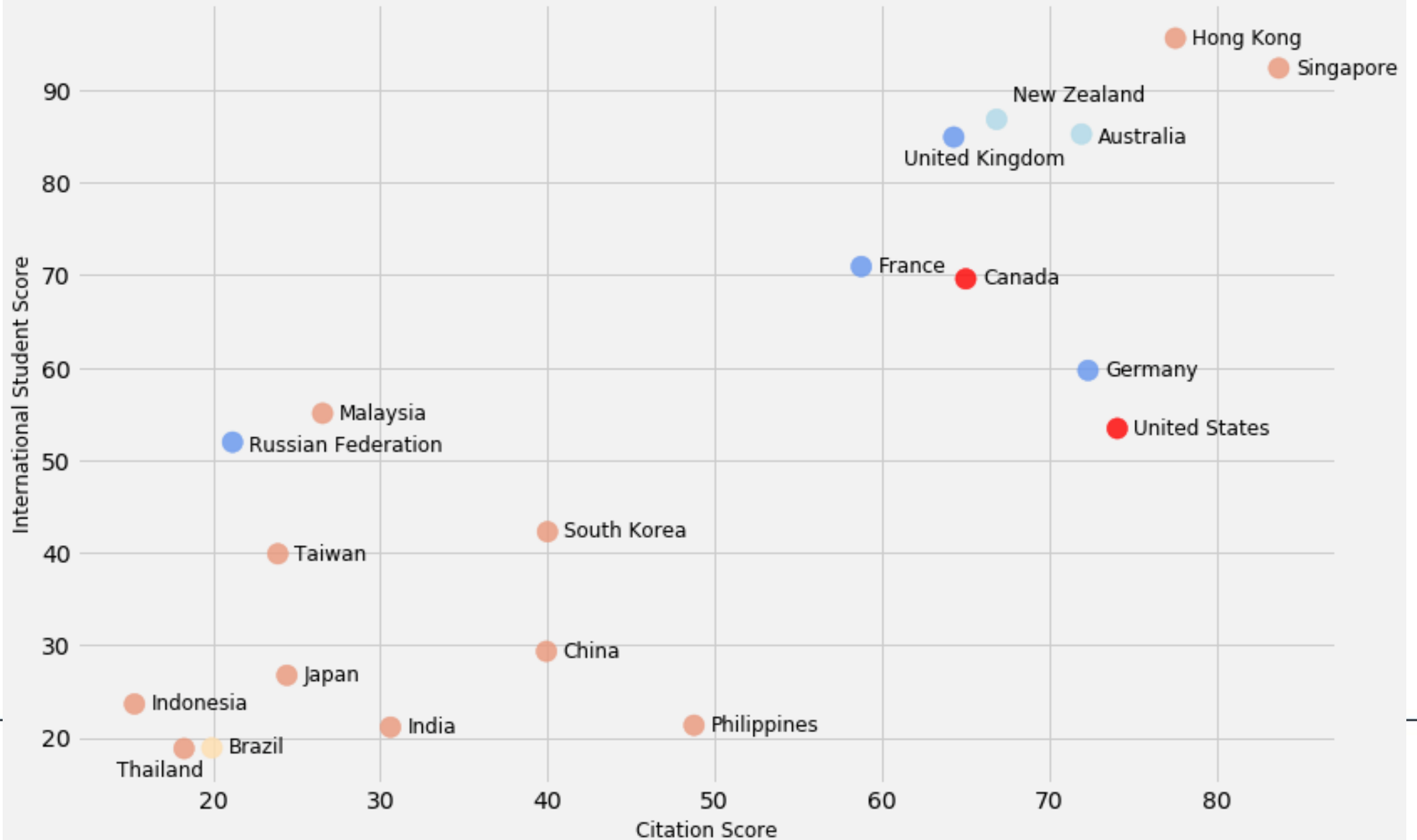
International Co-authorship Score vs Citation Score
