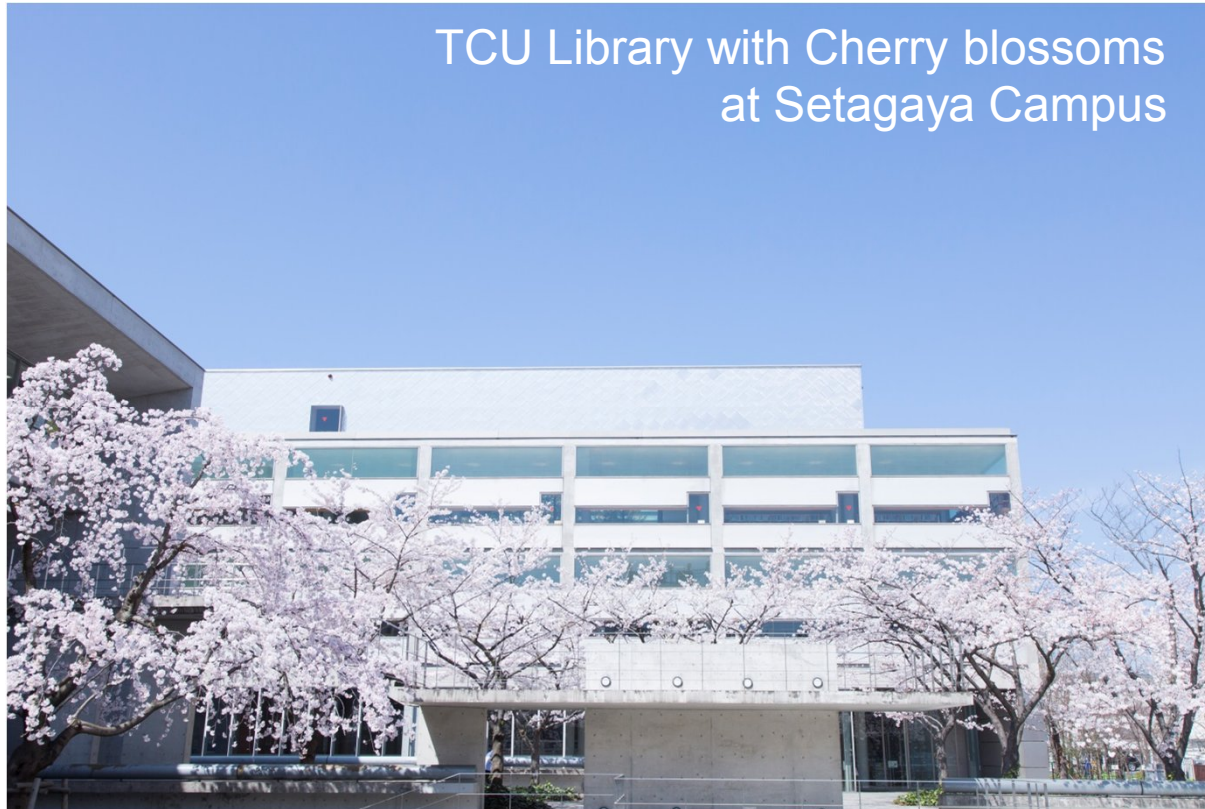

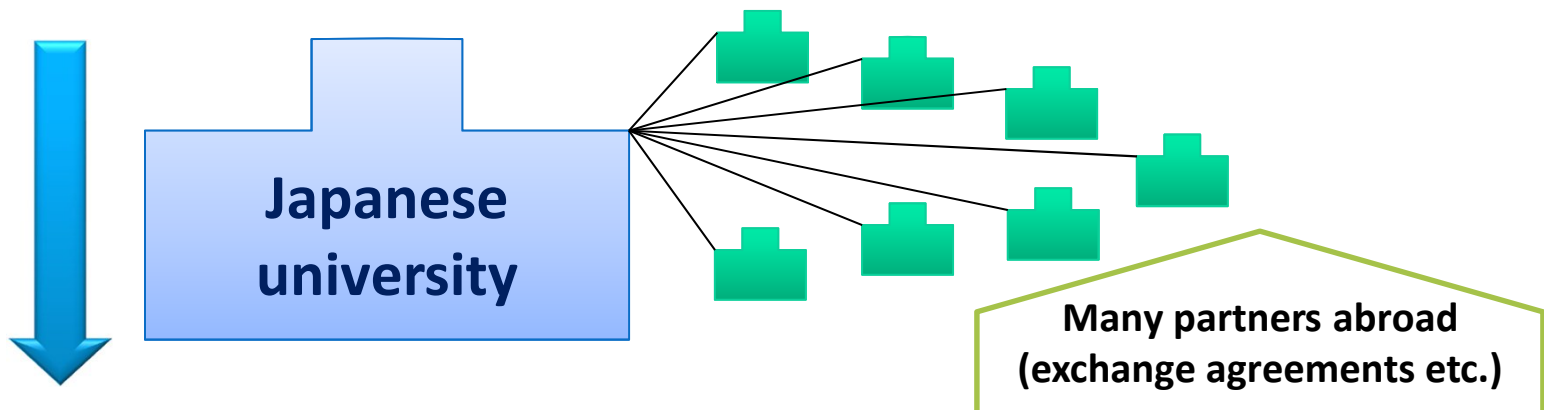

the more students they can send abroad.

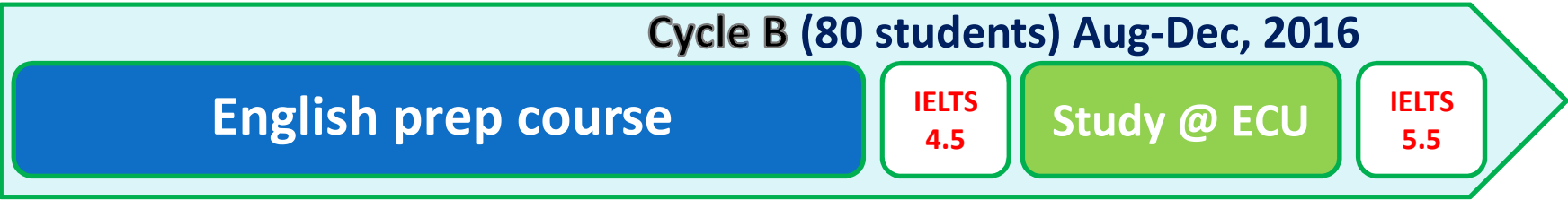
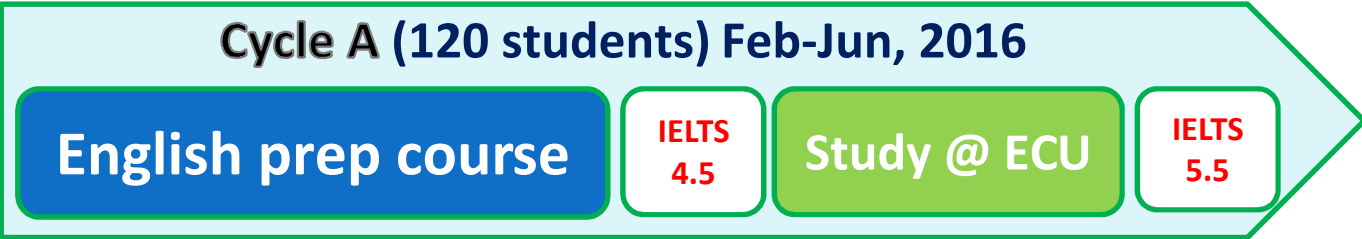
PROGRAM STRUCTURE



TOKYO CITY UNIVERSITY

Two-year program: FIRST YEAR ⇒ Study at TCU
▪ English preparatory education
▪ Monthly orientation on living in Perth
: SECOND YEAR ⇒ Study at ECU

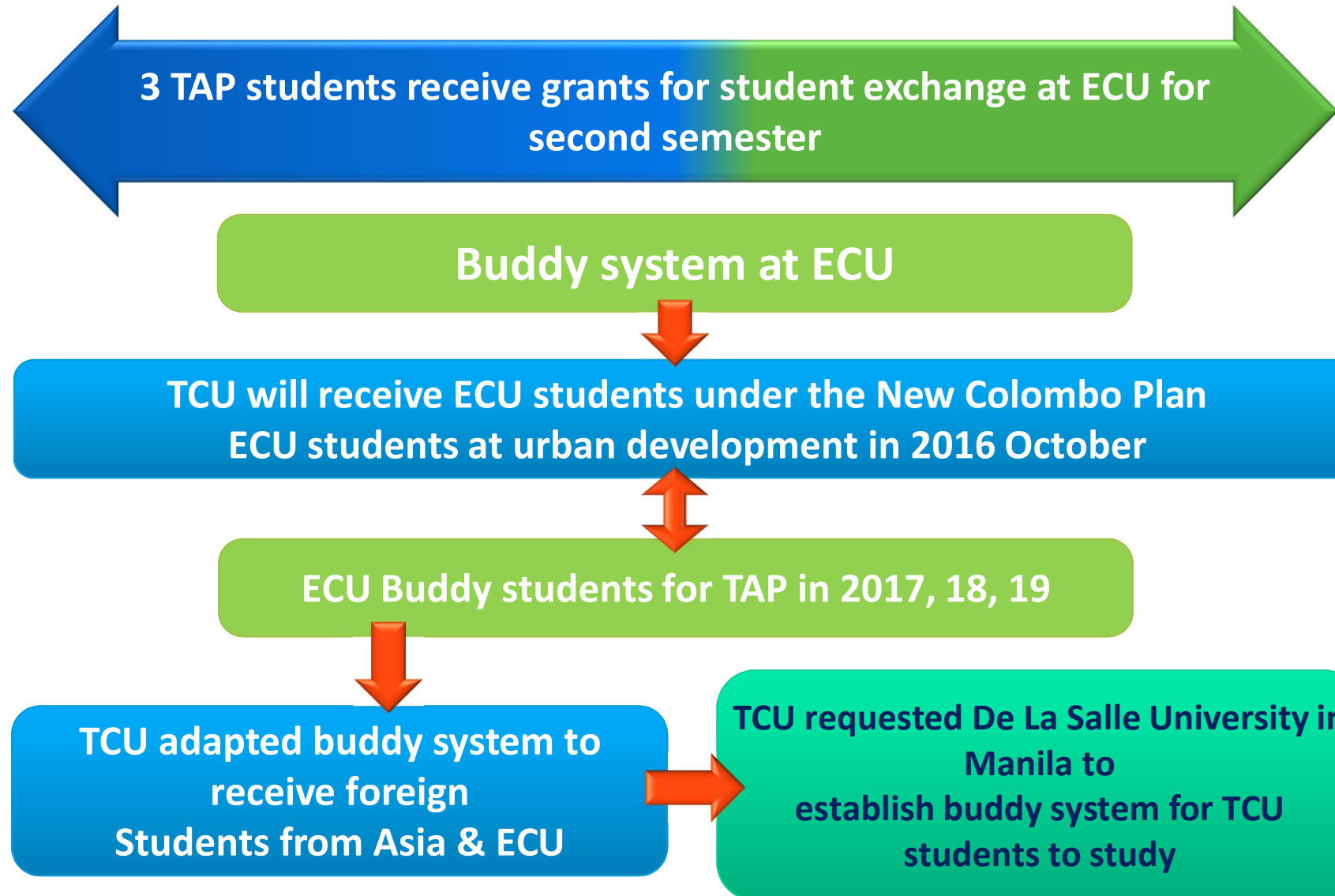

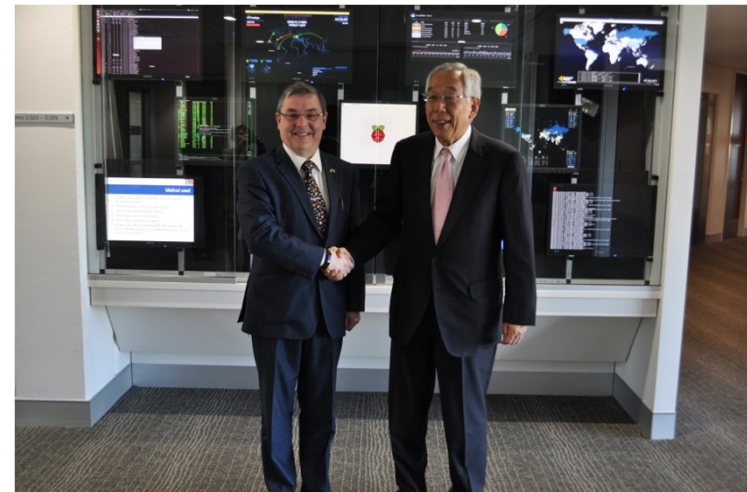
Difficulties for other universities to give attention to only one partner among many universities
