

Who attends AIEC?

The Australian International Education Conference (AIEC) is the major opportunity each year for international education practitioners, teaching staff, researchers, policy makers and other stakeholders to learn about major industry trends and development and to network with Australian and international colleagues.


Over 1,700 attendees from over 500 organisations attend the conference each year, including speakers, exhibitors and delegates. Approximately 20% of attendees come from overseas, and approximately 50% of Australian attendees are from New South Wales and Victoria. The conference attracts experts from all education sectors, including English language, schools, higher education and vocational education and training, as well as government representatives, NGO staff and private providers.

Attendees usually have a range of interests, which are explored through the different conference key interest areas showcased in the program, including: admissions and compliance, business development and strategy, employability, learning abroad, marketing and recruitment, pathways, professional development, scholarships and fellowships, student experience, teaching and learning, and transnational education. Approximately 70% of attendees have more than five years' experience working in international education, and approximately 10% have less than three years. Each year, about 40% of delegates attend the conference for the first time. The exhibition typically includes over 60 organisations.








Australian vs. Overseas


By state/territory








Attendees from around the world




By type of organisation




By key interest area

(Primary choice)






Sector interest





By primary occupation






First time attendees
