- The Kuwait is a small triangular-shaped of 17,820 square Kilometres






Population & Demographics

- 24% School aged population (4-21years)
- More males than females in the school age population



Education Investment



- Kuwait was ranked 63rd on Human Development Index 2011
- 13% of public expenditure was given for Education In 2006
- 94% Literacy rate at 2005
- International Scholarships 5000 6000 per year
