




### India student visa volumes



Estimated 10% of above visa grants are for UG students Germany , China have seen sharp growths



### **Proportion of students currently studying from top 3 source markets for MESC**







- 61% first in family to study abroad


Relative to other students, IDP Indian students placed **greater** importance on:

Nearly **1/2** of Indian students chose their study destination **themselves** 


