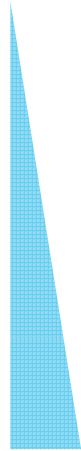

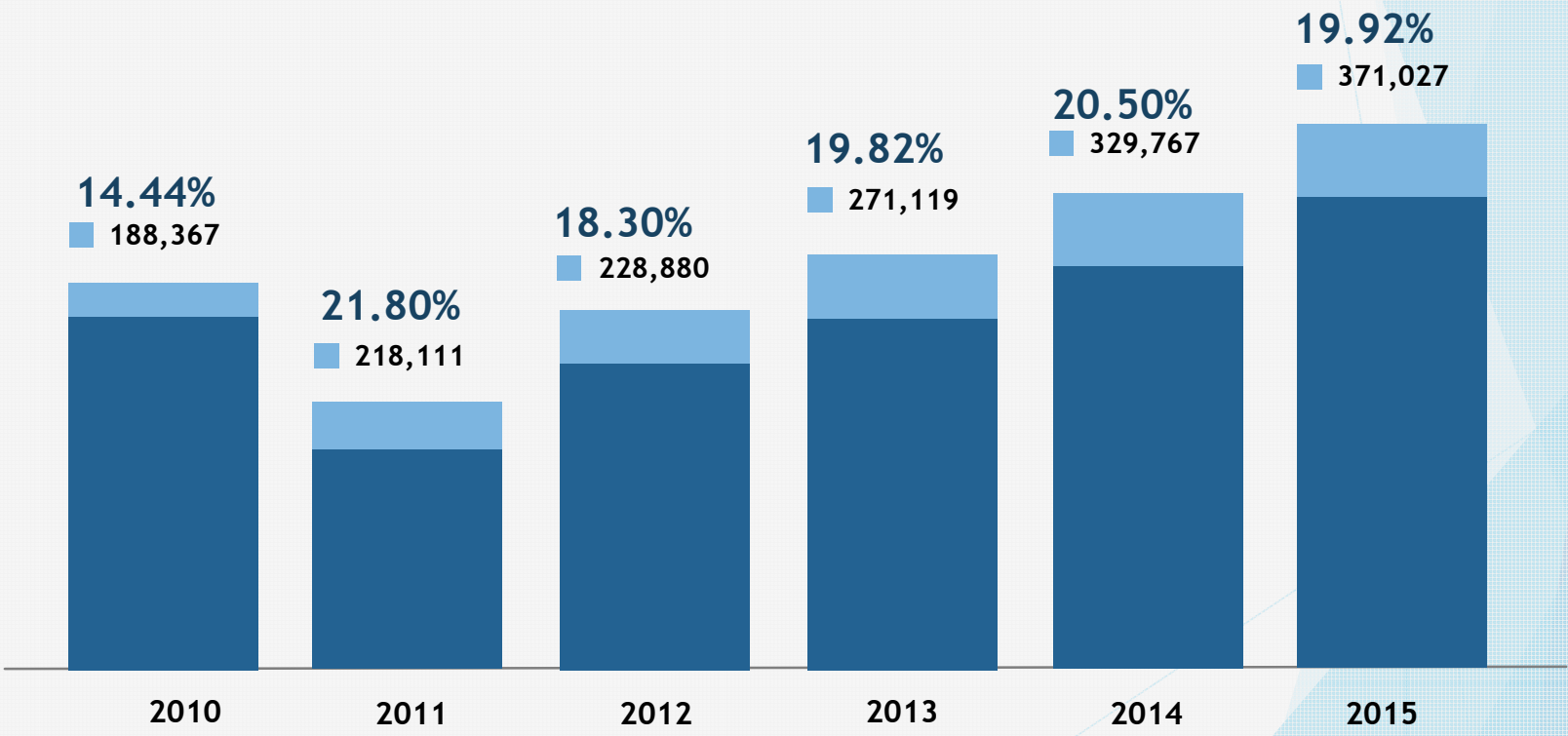

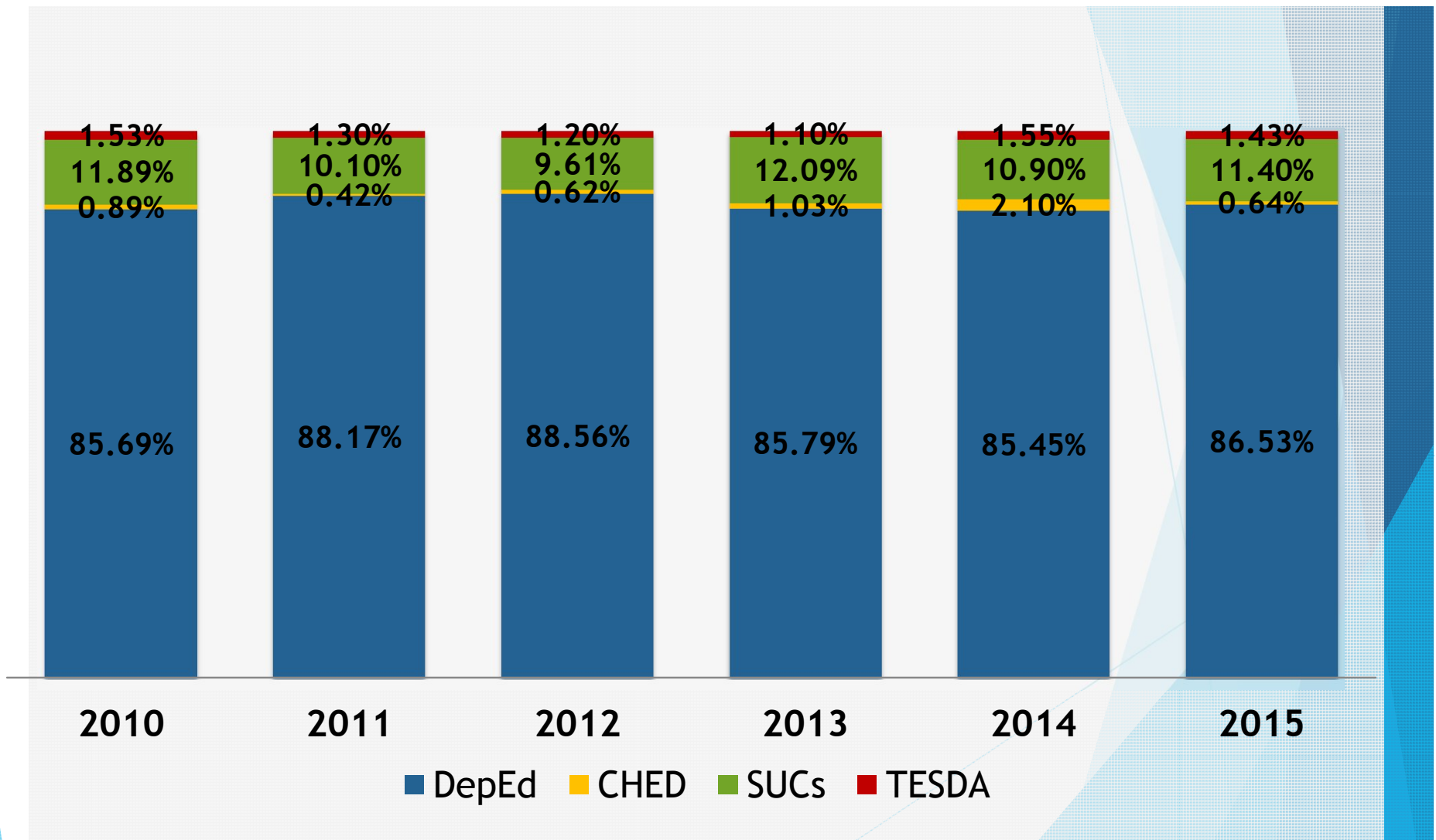

Government Investment in Education

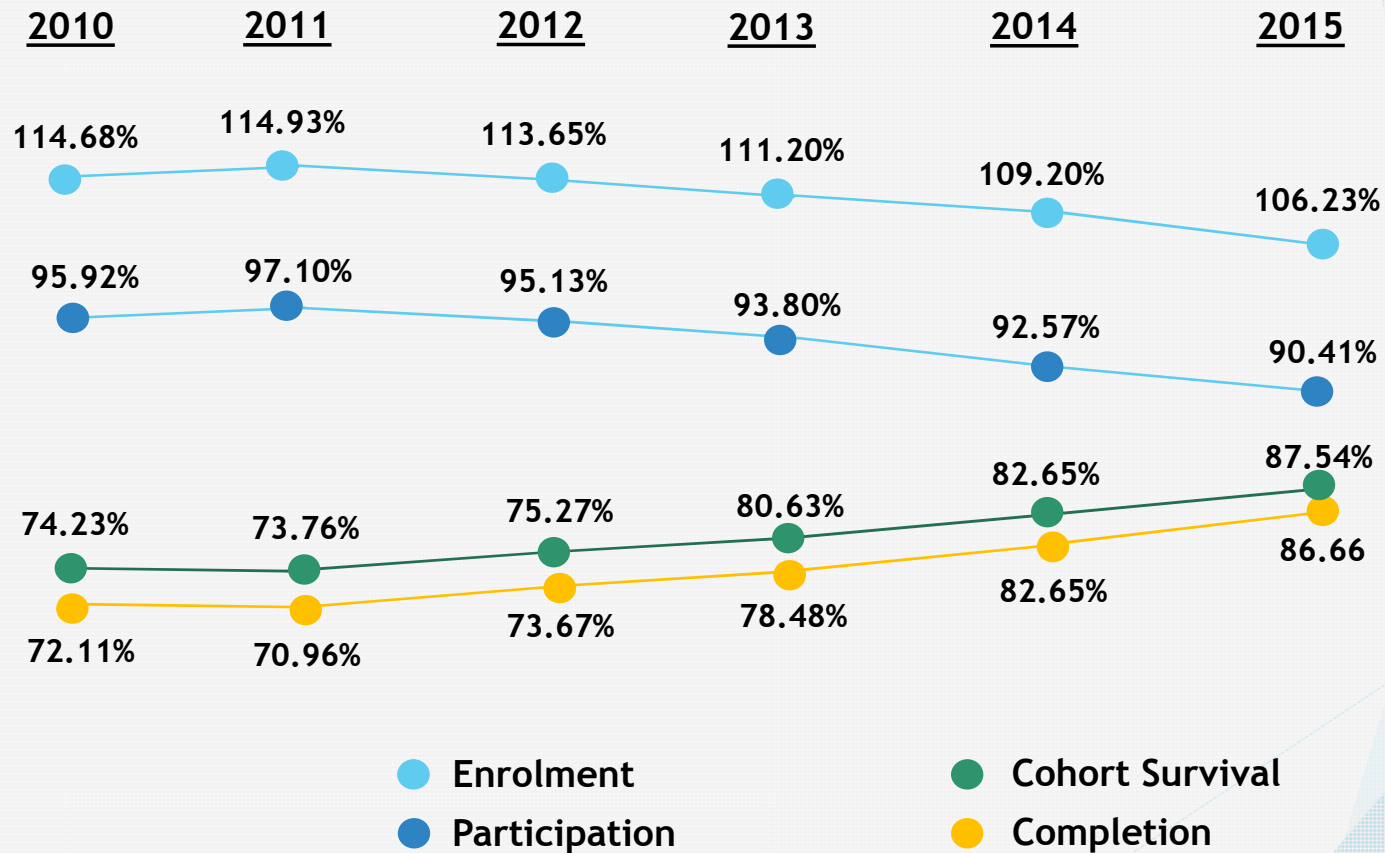

Elementary education output



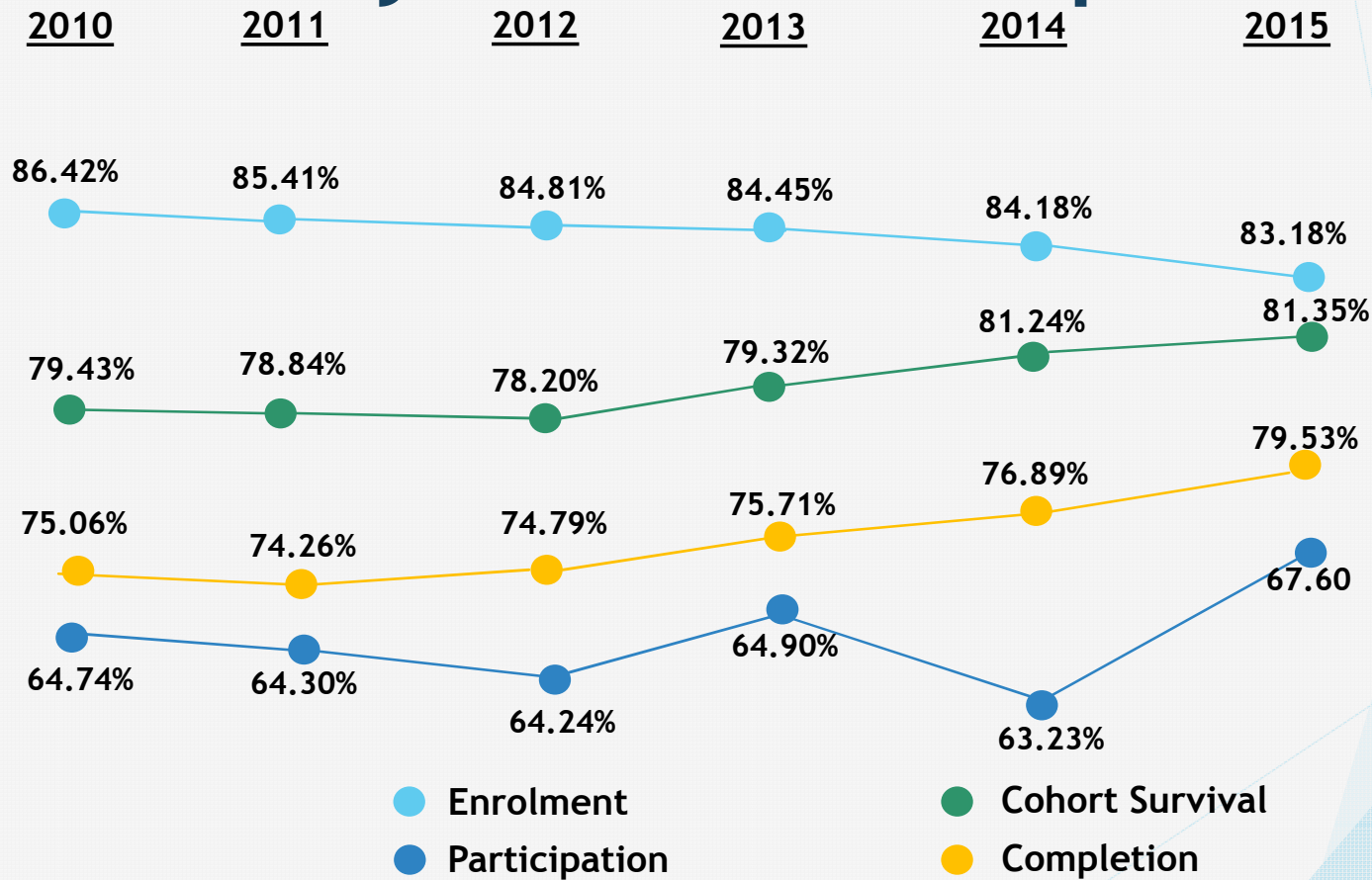

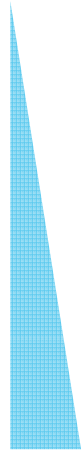

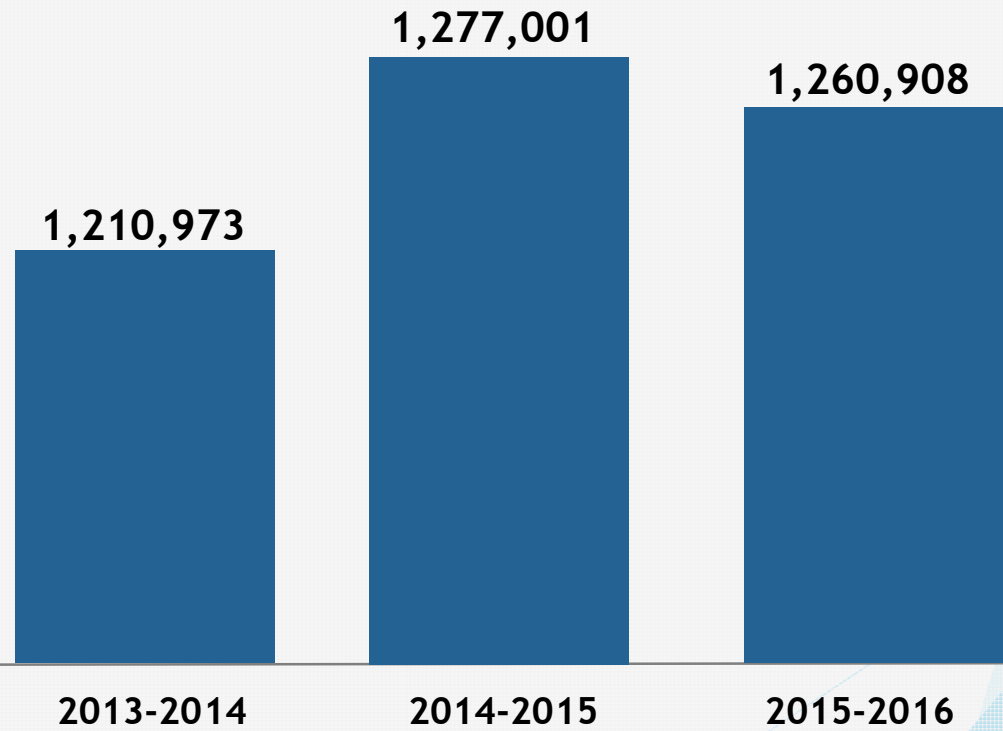

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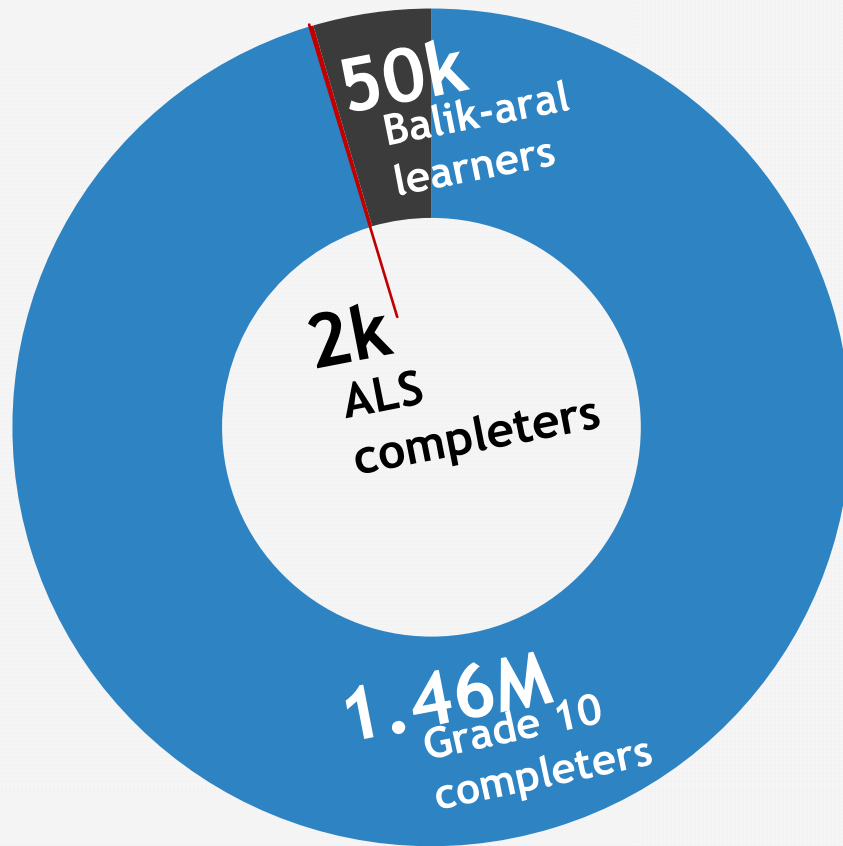
Public High School Enrolment

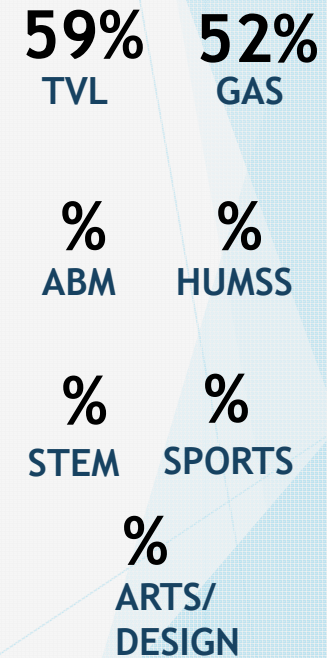


Senior High School (SHS) on its rollout

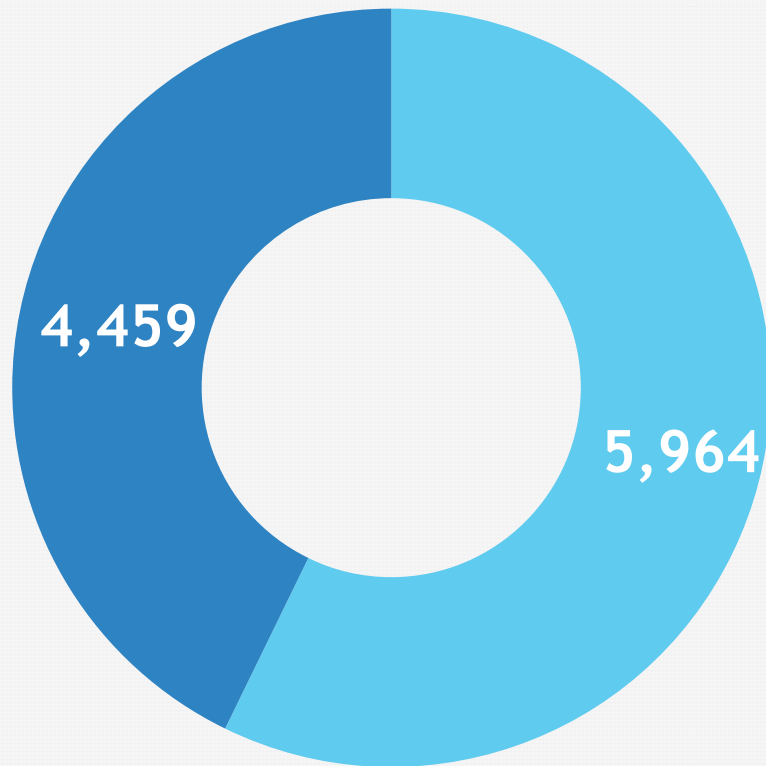
G11 enrolment by origin

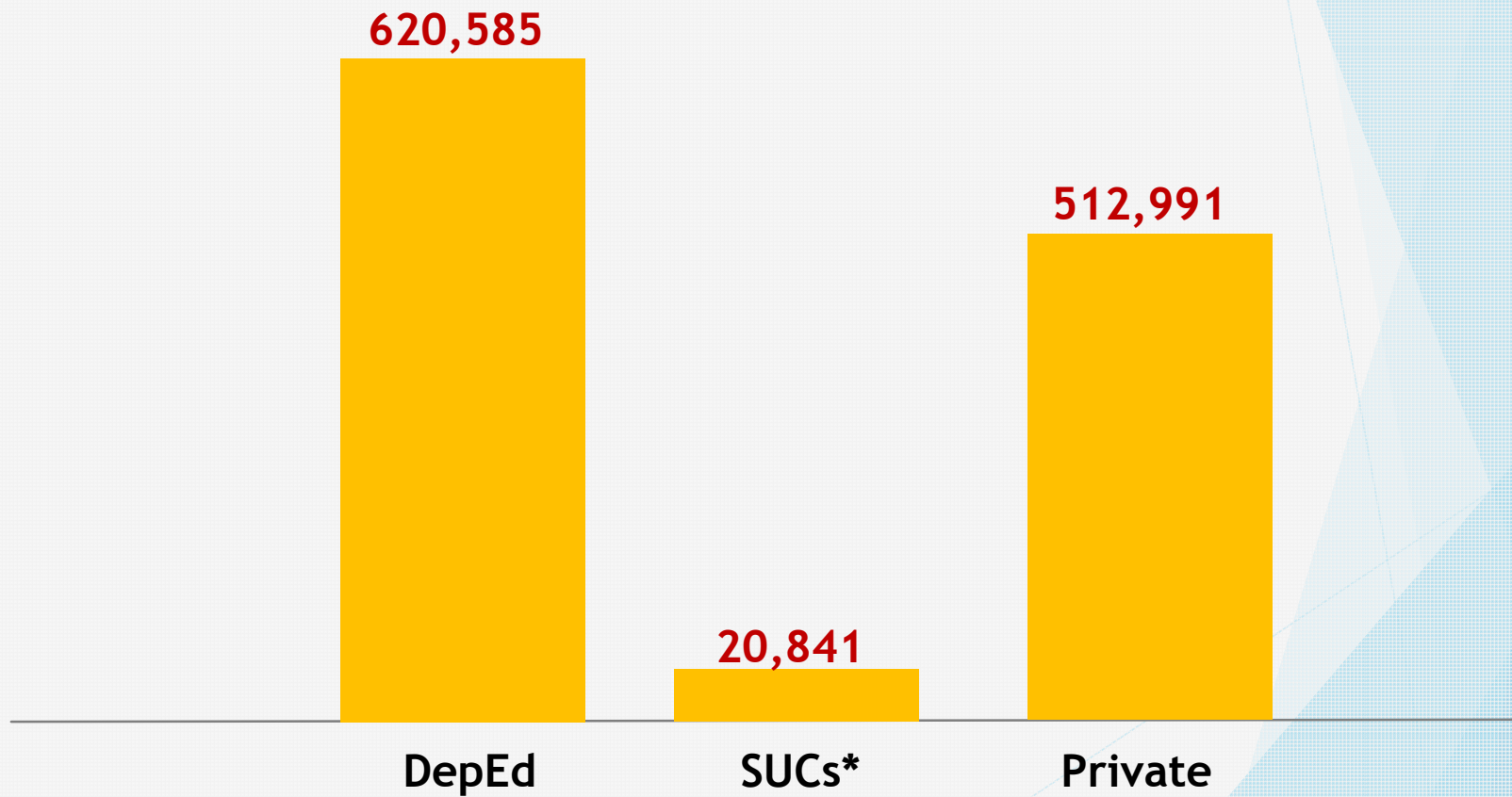

SHS Enrolment

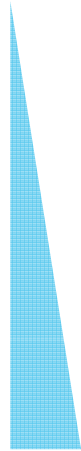

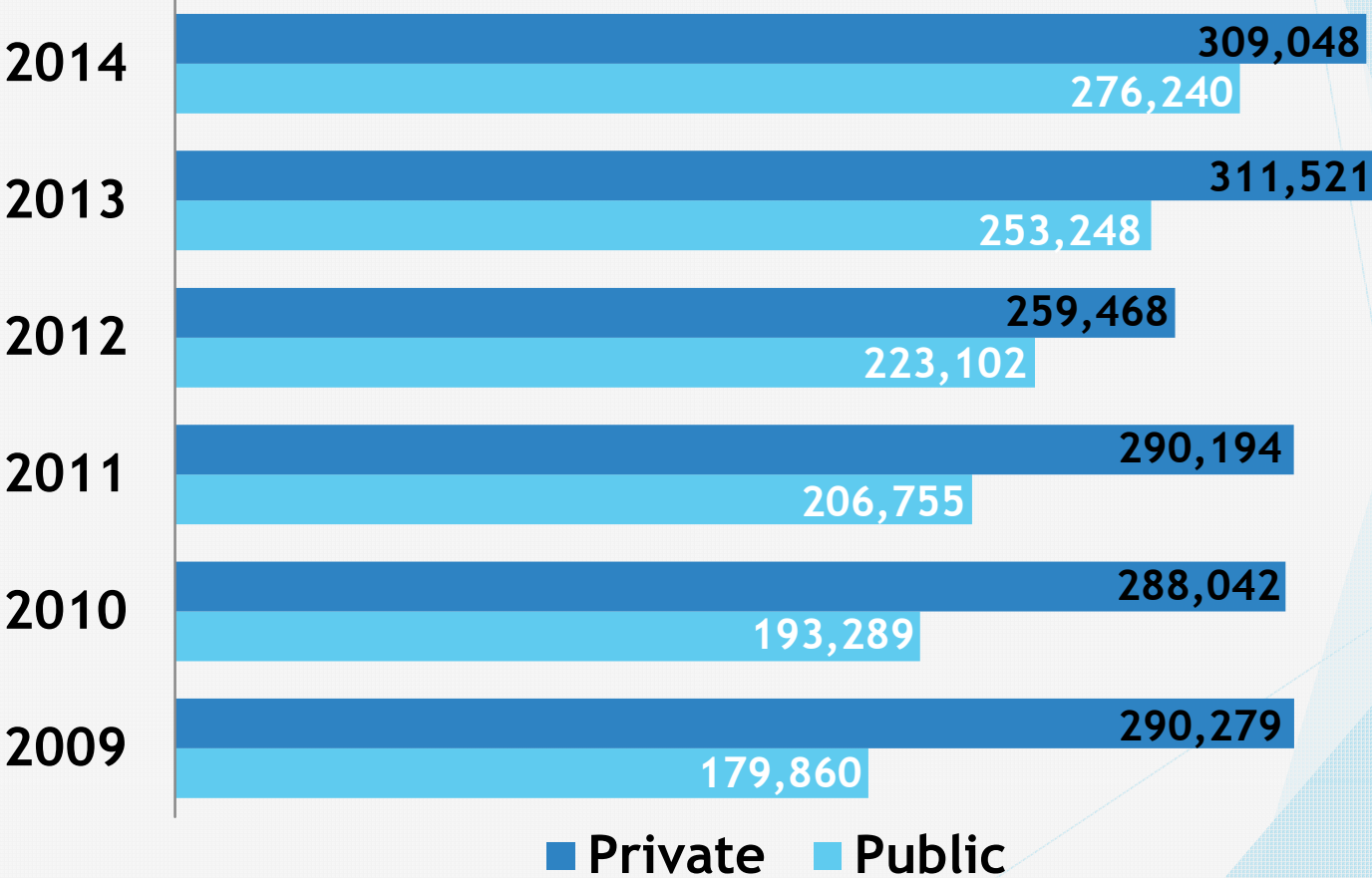
