

LUGGAGE AND PACKING - PART 2

- Pack a pair of black, leather shoes - this will be part of your school uniform
- If you are taking prescribed medication ask your doctor to write a letter (translated into English) stating why you need the medicine and detailing your medical history
- Australian regulations enable you to bring no more than A\$10,000 or foreign currency equivalent. For safety and security reasons do not travel with large amounts of money. You are able to withdraw money from Automatic Teller Machines (ATM) at Sydney International Airport.
