

The principles underpinning Navitas' Internationalisation framework




Drawing on good practice in the area of internationalisation in education, diversity of thought and perspectives, and on Navitas' own values, the framework is based on the following principles:


- Internationalisation is promoted as a key part of the Navitas experience for all students;

- Intercultural competencies are embedded in the curriculum and in teacher capability and professional development.










Participants

Join a table

Each table has a theme, host and scribes;

For your table's theme, prepare a list of experiences, advice and cautionary notes.

Think about your context:

- What are your biggest successes so far in relation to this theme?
- What are your biggest challenges in relation to this theme?
- What will be required to overcome any challenges?

Table hosts

For the first round, introduce yourself and invite participants to introduce themselves

Introduce your table's theme and guide discussion

Scribes write notes from each group onto butchers paper

At the start of the new round, welcome the group, introduce yourself and share the essence of the discussion so far.


Invite additions.
